DAY 1: FLIGHT TO ROME

Today marks the exciting beginning of your pilgrimage as you embark on your flight to the enchanting city of Rome. Settle in, relax, and enjoy the meals and drinks served as you travel toward this historic destination.

DAY 2: DISCOVER ROME

Welcome to Rome! You'll be greeted by our guide and driver as we embark on a panoramic tour of the city. Our first stop is the stunning Trevi Fountain—don't forget to toss a coin and make a wish! Next, we'll visit the iconic Pantheon and the beautiful Spanish Steps. In the evening, enjoy a delightful dinner before settling in at your hotel for the night, getting ready for more exploration tomorrow.

DAY 3: PAPAL AUDIENCE / THE VATICAN

We rise early, excited for a special day! After breakfast, we'll head to St. Peter's Square for the Papal Audience (subject to schedule). Then, we'll visit St. Peter's Basilica for Mass before enjoying a guided tour of the Vatican Museums and the Sistine Chapel. After an inspiring day, we'll have dinner and return to our hotel for a restful night.

DAY 4: ANCIENT ROME

Today, we explore Rome's spiritual and historical treasures, starting with St. Paul Outside the Walls and the Catacombs, immersing ourselves in early Christian history. Next, we'll tour Ancient

Rome, including the Coliseum, Capitol Hill, Vittorio Emmanuel Monument, Roman Forum, and Circus Maximus. In the afternoon, we visit St. Mary Major and St. John in Lateran, followed by some free time to wander the streets of Rome. The day concludes with a delightful dinner at our hotel.

DAY 5: MONTE CASSINO & SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO

As we journey south through Italy's picturesque countryside, the scenery of vineyards, orchards, and olive groves enchants us. Our first destination is Monte Cassino, founded by St. Benedict in 529. Here, we will explore the majestic Abbey and the Church of St. Peter and Paul. Afterward, we'll continue to San Giovanni Rotondo, the beloved hometown of St. Padre Pio, where we'll have dinner and unwind at our hotel.

DAY 6: SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO & MONTE SANT' ANGELO

We begin the day with a heartfelt Mass at St. Padre Pio's tomb, followed by a tour of the significant sanctuary. Witness the old church, the crucifix where he received the stigmata, and spend a moment in reflection at the confessional. We'll pray before St. Padre Pio's incorrupt body and then head to the Grotto of St. Michael the Archangel for stunning views of the Gargano Peninsula. After a fulfilling day, we'll enjoy dinner and return to our cozy hotel.

DAY 7: LANCIANO / LORETO / ASSISI

Today, we travel to Lanciano to visit the Church of St. Longinus and witness the Eucharistic Miracle during Mass. Next, we head to the Adriatic coast to explore the Marian Shrine of Loreto and admire the Holy House of Nazareth. After lunch, we'll continue to Assisi, the hometown of St. Francis. We'll end our day with dinner and an overnight stay at our hotel!

DAY 8: ASSISI

This morning, we celebrate Mass at St. Mary of the Angels Basilica, where St. Francis began his ministry and St. Clare her journey. We'll tour the Basilica of St. Francis of Assisi, viewing significant artifacts, including the crucifix that spoke to him. Visiting the chapel where he prayed and the Church of St. Clare, home to her relics, will deepen our sense of connection. The rest of the day is free for shopping or relaxation, followed by dinner and a restful night at our hotel.

DAY 9: ASSISI / SIENA / FLORENCE

Today, we'll explore Siena, marveling at the stunning Romanesque-Gothic cathedral completed in 1380. We'll visit the Sanctuary of St. Catherine, where she received her stigmata, and stroll through the shell-shaped Piazza del Campo, admiring Palazzo Pubblico and the Torre Del Mangia. We'll also see St. Catherine's incorrupt relics at the Basilica of St. Dominic before heading to Florence for dinner and overnight accommodations.

DAY 10: FLORENCE

Get ready to explore the beauty of Florence! We'll begin at the Church of the Holy Cross, the resting place of greats like Michelangelo and Galileo. Our walking tour will lead us through Piazza Signoria, past Palazzo Vecchio and the Uffizi Gallery, to the iconic Ponte Vecchio and Republic Square, ending at the stunning Cathedral of Santa Maria del Fiore. After the tour, we'll visit L'Accademia to see masterpieces by Botticelli and Michelangelo's David. Enjoy some free time to explore before dinner and overnight at the hotel!

DAY 11: MILAN

Our journey continues as we head to Milan! We'll visit the stunning Duomo, tour the Basilica di Sant'Ambrogio, and the Tomb of St. Ambrose. We aim to celebrate Mass at the Church of Santa Maria delle Grazie, and then explore the historic Castel Sforzesco and the famous La Scala Opera House. You'll have time to shop at the stylish boutiques and stroll through the Galleria Vittorio Emanuele. In the evening, we'll enjoy a meal with our spiritual director and fellow pilgrims, reflecting on our trip before relaxing at our hotel for the night.

DAY 12: RETURN FLIGHT HOME

This morning, we'll gather for a heartfelt transfer to the airport, where we will begin our return flight home, filled with cherished memories and spiritual growth from this extraordinary journey.

Your Package Includes

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

Baggage: Nativity Pilgrimage limits all passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, Porterage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees

Medical Insurance: Coverage for the duration of your trip.

Cancellation Protection Plan: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

General Travel Information

Group Air: Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Departure Cities: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the 'Land Only" option. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

Important Nativity Pilgrimage Policies

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Single Room: Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Seat Location Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Other Special Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a Wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily)

Booking Conditions of Aires

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due 07/18/25 (100 Days before departure). Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

Payment Methods: We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, Zelle payments, and ACH transactions. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

Late Payment Policy

Customers will receive Late Fees if they are not paid in full:

Days Prior to Departure	Fee

30 days - day before departure	subject to cancellation

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

Cancellation/Refund Policy

We hope that nothing will prevent you from taking your pilgrimage with Nativity Pilgrimage, however, should you need to cancel your trip, your cancellation must be in writing via email or letter. It will be effective on the date of receipt. The following cancellation fees will apply:
