Dear Friends in Christ,

This will be a short letter, since the Three Kings have arrived! Just a parenthetical information, though, St. Francis began the first Christmas creche in the Italian village of Grecio. As the years rolled by, the cast of characters were added and may not be biblically accurate in some way, but the point is clear: to foster a deeper faith in us through the Nativity Scene. Whether the three kings arrived in Bethlehem or years after should no longer be a matter of concern. For as long as we center on the message of Christmas, Jesus Himself, then the depiction of the manger scene helps and encourages us in our daily lives.



On a separate topic, there is a goodbye note in this bulletin from Deacon Gino. We thank him for his service to our parish as Business Manager. It was during his term, under the pastorship of Fr.
