

The Epiphany of Our Lord is the Christian feast observed today. January 8, 2023.

The word "epiphany" comes from the Greek epiphainen, a verb that means "to shine upon," "to manifest," or "to make known." Thus, the feast of the Epiphany celebrates the many ways that Christ has made Himself

known to the world, mainly through the three events that manifested the mission and divinity of Christ: the visit of the Magi (Matthew 2:1-12), the baptism of Jesus (Mark 1:9-11), and the miracle at Cana (John 2:1-11).

Notes from Fr. PJ

Dear Friends in Christ,

Time did fly, though it does not have wings.

We celebrate the Epiphany of our Lord this weekend, as we also adjust our Mass schedule: 7:30, 10, and 12 Noon on Sunday mornings and 5 in the afternoon. On Monday, we celebrate our Lord's Baptism. Then, Tuesday? Back to green vestments for priests and deacons for liturgical wear. It will then be Tuesday of the First Week in Ordinary Time.

Wednesday, January 11th, will also be Fr. Bill O'Brien's first death anniversary. Kindly remember to say a prayer for him and the repose of his soul.

The word "epiphany" means "showing" or "revealing." The wise men (and women), who came from all over the ancient world to the manger in Bethlehem, revealed the baby Jesus to the world. I don't think that all these visitors arrived at the same time and for just a single day. Synchronizing their arrival dates and travel times with their watches was not yet common back then. But that's just my opinion.

However, there may have been more than three wise men. The number three was just attributed to the number of gifts offered: gold, frankincense, and myrrh. I also think there may have been wise women in that first foreign audience by our Lord. (Wisdom is for those who seek and find God since fools say in their heart that there is no God. And so, they do not seek Him.)

And since the visitors from foreign lands did not just present their gifts and then leave, I also think that they stayed for quite a while in the company of the Holy Family. Maybe they stayed at the inn that was denied that Christmas night to Joseph and Mary, or perhaps pitched a tent with the shepherds. The whole contingent alone would have originated the first buffet party in history—mostly potluck, I suppose. This is the time when St. Martha could have time-traveled to attend to the visitors. But, we are getting ahead of the story.

So, there we are with Jesus once again revealing Himself to us, as He always does and often, especially in the celebration of our living sacraments.

May we then remain open to His revelation, to God's epiphany in our lives and hearts. Amen.






