

Notes from Fr. PJ

Dear Parishioners

Happy New Year and may the Peace and Blessings of Christ be with you and your families. I thought I would take this opportunity to update you on a few things that have been going on at St Veronica.



- You may have noticed the College Achieve signs around campus. College Achieve is a charter school renting Holy Innocents Parish in Neptune that sustained tremendous water damage over Christmas break from extensive broken pipes. We have granted them temporary and emergency usage of a large portion (58,700 sq ft) of the Parish center/school building so that they can continue to educate their 500 students. The temporary usage is dependent on how quickly their building can be repaired so at this time it is a minimum of 3 weeks but most likely will be 6-8 weeks. I must say it has been so wonderful to have all the young energy of children around us. While setting up their own classrooms, College Achieve staff have helped St. Veronica pack up and move remaining items from MSA.
- We also sustained considerable damage to the Rainbow patch/preschool wing of the school building over Christmas break. Although we were proactive with DGC, our HVAC company, coming in to inspect all heating units prior to the expected 4 degree temperature and having the heat turned up, five domestic water pipes split. This damage is being covered by our insurance. We only have a \$1000 deductible. Since College Achieve was coming in to occupy the building, the repairs were slated priority and all work was completed in a week's time. Unfortunately, we did lose some preschool furniture, rugs and other preschool educational items that were not covered by insurance.
- The exterior lights on the Parish center were repaired prior to Christmas so now the area has ample lighting for the nighttime hours. Also, several light switches inside the building (bathrooms and the 1st floor hallway) have also been switched over to motion detector sensor switches so that they do not remain on all day. Soon we will have an evaluation done of the building to begin the process of switching out light fixtures to LED to help drastically cut our energy consumption in the buildings. There are grants available to help with the cost of the switch over.
- Several months ago, I applied for the NJ NSGP (Nonprofit Security Grant Program) through the NJ Office of Homeland Security and we were awarded \$150,000 in grant funds. More information to follow in the coming months on how those funds will continue to secure our parish campus.
- Unfortunately I had to put the Office Kiosk in the Narthex on hold for a few weeks as we have no volunteers to help us man the kiosk. If you are interested in helping welcome parishioners and guests, provide them answers to simple questions, and help with simple tasks before and after the Mass you are attending, please let me know and email me at businessmanager@stveronica.com.
