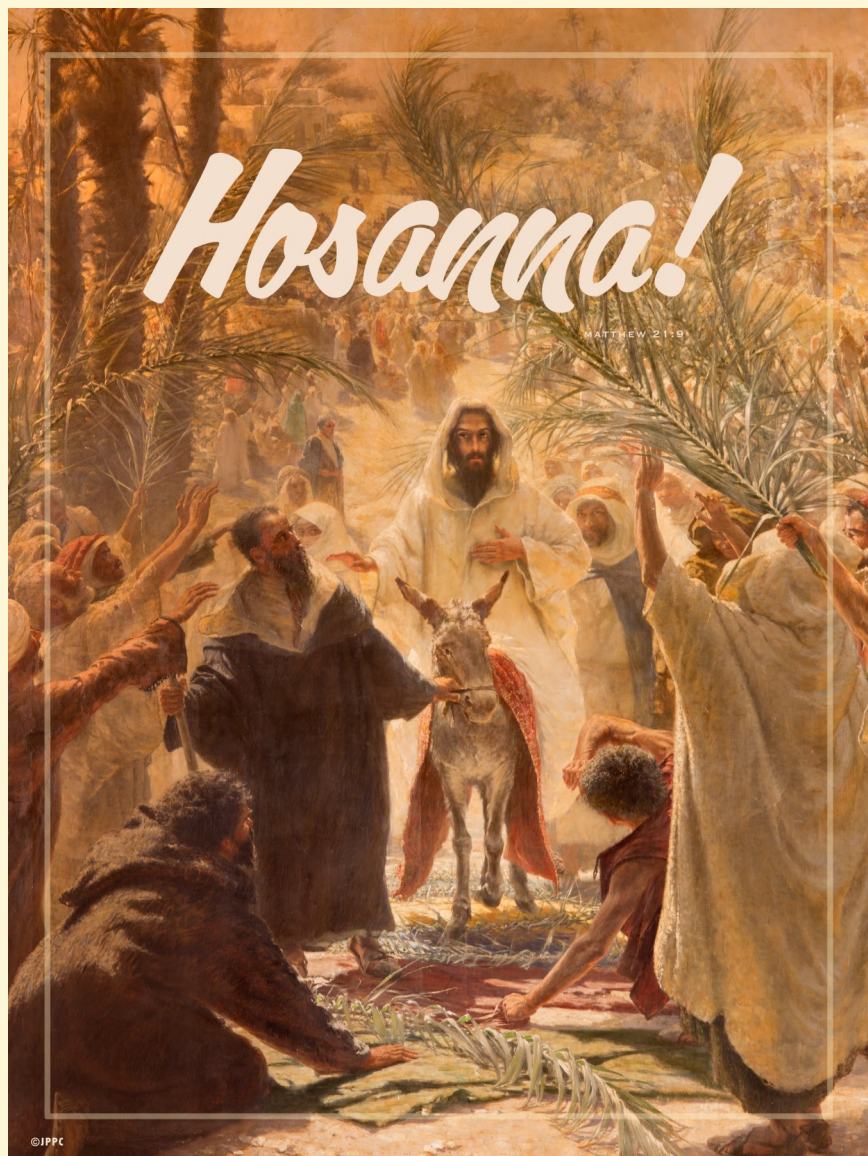

Notes from Father PJ

Dear Friends in Christ,

Peace!

Before everything else, kindly accept my wishes and prayers for you and your loved ones as we begin this year's holiest of weeks in our church's calendar. May you have a truly blessed Holy Week!



Palm Sunday. We'll have the Blessing and Distribution of the Palms as we remember Christ's triumphant entry into Jerusalem. The "Hosannas" of praise uttered that day contradicted the "Crucify Him" mob shouting within a week's time. The Gospel for the Mass is rather lengthy. Be prepared to sacrifice a little bit of your time and energy standing on your feet during the reading of the Gospel.

Monday of Holy Week. Bishop O'Connell will lead the Chrism Mass celebration at St. Robert's Co-Cathedral. Our Clergy will renew our vows before him, and the sacramental oils will be blessed.

Tuesday of Holy Week. This is new in our parish this year. We'll have a 9:00AM to 9:00PM Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, while our priests will take turns hearing Confessions during those twelve hours. The Blessed Sacrament will be reposed at 11:30AM in preparation for the 12:00 Noon Mass and will be exposed again once Mass is over.

Wednesday of Holy Week. It is also called Spy Wednesday, as it is believed that Judas betrayed Jesus on this day.

Holy Thursday. We have the Commemoration of the Lord's Supper at 7:00PM. The Washing of the Feet, also called Mandatum, the Renewal of Commitment by our priests, the Procession of the Holy Oils, and the Transfer of the Blessed Sacrament to the Altar of Repose are also held, among other meaningful sacred activities and rituals. The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed until 12:00AM.

Good Friday. There are two outdoor processions: at 12:00PM and at 7:00PM. At 3:00PM, we'll commemorate our Lord's Passion and Death. There will be Adoration of the Cross, the Solemn Intercession prayers, and Distribution of Communion. This is the only day in our calendar when no Mass is celebrated

Holy Saturday. At 8:00PM, we'll have the Easter Vigil. This will be a great experience for me, and I invite you to participate. And why? Because we have 25 fellow parishioners in the RCIA program, 5 will be baptized, and 17 will be confirmed. Blessing of the New Fire and the Paschal Candle, Blessing of the Baptismal Font, and Renewal of our Baptismal Promises are some of the major components of the celebration.

Easter Sunday. At 6:00AM, I will lead the SONrise Service at Our Lady's Grotto, adjacent to our Adoration Chapel. Then follows a 7:30AM Mass, two Masses at 10:00AM (Church and Hall) and two Masses at 12:00 noon (Church and Hall). No 5:00PM Mass on Easter Sunday. We gotta be early or at the early part of the day to see the SON rise! 😊 It might be tricky seeing Him rise when the sun is about to set.

Till then, keep well and take care.

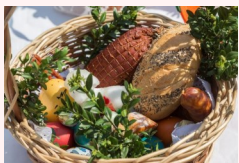

The Blessing of Easter Food Baskets

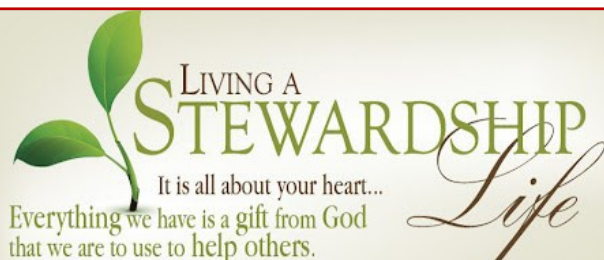
will take place on Holy Saturday,
April 8, 2023 at 1:00PM in the Church.

In many Eastern European countries, it is an important tradition to have a basket of food blessed on Holy Saturday or Easter Sunday. *Święconka* means "the blessing of the Easter baskets." It is one of the most enduring and beloved Polish traditions. This blessing is still found in the updated Roman Ritual, and is a wonderful practice for all families. Many parishes including St. Veronica Parish still participates in this custom of the blessing of the Easter food or baskets. The food items placed in the Easter basket for blessing have special significance.

Although each family may have its own traditions, there are some practices that are universal. A typical Eastern European Easter basket would include a variety of symbolic foods. There is a special blessing for meat, egg, cake, and bread, so baskets will most likely include these ingredients. Bacon, Easter Bread, Butter, Candles, Cheese, Colored Eggs, Ham, Sausage Links, Horseradish, and Salt.
