

Notes from Father PJ

Dear Friends in Christ,

Peace and Easter Joy to you and your family!

Some of us who are a little bit older might remember the movie, "Jaws." Three men in that movie are out at sea searching for the Great White Shark. At one point in the movie, they find themselves sharing horror stories. Each one has scars and each one tries to one up each other. One of the characters has scars from the war; another has scars from a previous shark attack.



Enter the character played by Richard Dreyfus. He rips open his chest without speaking a word. "What caused that?" one man asks, "Bypass surgery?" "Nope," says Dreyfus. "Betty Sue, 7th Grade. She broke my heart."

The scars of Good Friday on our Lord's Body were some of the springboards of Thomas the Apostle's faith and belief in Christ's Resurrection. To see the scars for him means to acknowledge and believe that Jesus the Nazorean is really and truly risen.

There is something about scars that seems to make a person more human. There is something about scars that makes us trustworthy and real. The scars of Jesus mean that He is also one of us.

All of us have scars. We cannot live life without being hurt. What makes us human are our scars and our bodily imperfections: pimples, flabby bellies (that's me!), graying hair, failing memories, clumping cellulites, wrinkles.

We also have a permanently scarred God-Man, in the person of our Lord Jesus Christ. Whatever scars we bear, whatever wound we carry, whatever doubts we harbor, Jesus comes bruised and scarred to be with us. That our good Lord would continue to carry the scars, the reminders of the pain and humiliation he went through, is the good Lord's way of saying to you and me each day of our lives, "I Love you!"

With the scars we have in common and when our time comes in the presence of our Lord, may we be able to express those words of belief, faith, and trust—same words that Thomas uttered form his heart—"My Lord and my God!"
