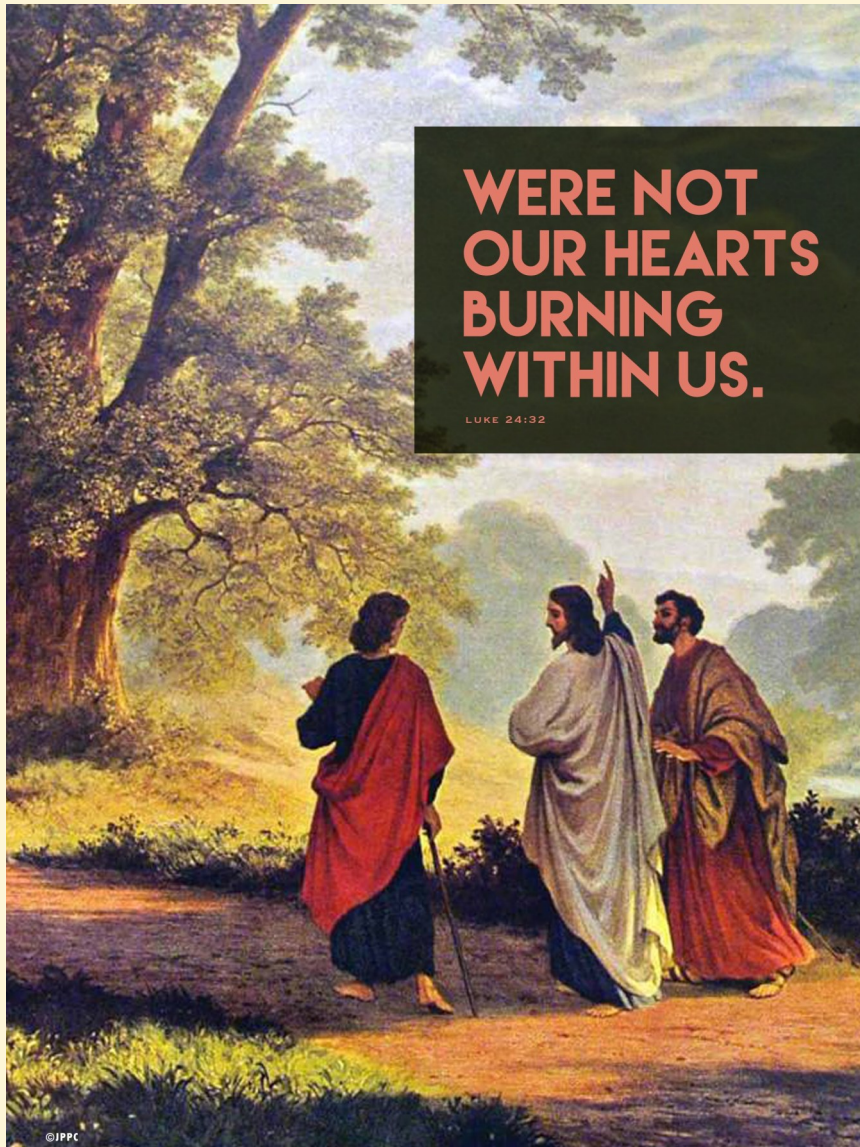

Notes from Father PJ

Dear Friends in Christ,

Easter Peace and Joy to you and your loved ones!

Just two short notes for this weekend. Kindly get your tickets for our 60th Gala Dinner on June 11th. Some of us have already bought the 50/50 tickets (there's a lot more to sell, so please avail of it), but it is good to be the first to know that we won (yes, we all will win in some way or another) if we are there at our parish event.



Secondly, the appearance of the Risen Christ on the Road to Emmaus. Your response to the following questions, asked by our Lord to the two disciples in this weekend's Gospel, is fundamental to the burning hearts that we need to have:

- What are you discussing as you walk along?
- What sort of things?
- Was it not necessary that the Christ should suffer into these things and enter into his glory?

Some practical and relevant considerations to question number one. More questions, if I may add. Our lives may be likened to the two disciples' journey to Emmaus (where they eventually see Jesus with their hearts when He broke the bread). What are we saying/conversing/concerning ourselves as we walk along this road? Are the things we are talking about of value and significance to the life we live now? How many hours do we spend talking about these things?

Question 2—what sort of things? The two disciples told Jesus about what happened to their Lord. They did not yet know that it was Jesus they were talking to. They dismissed the message of the women, whose testimony then was considered worthless in court and in law, as a "tale" or a "vision." Many times in our lives, Jesus is walking with us. And sometimes, in those quiet moments, there is that voice asking us, "what sort of things are you concerned about?" And by extension, would you believe what the women had said about the Risen Suffering Messiah?

Finally, was it not necessary that the Messiah should suffer so as to enter into God's glory? Right on target. It was a bullseye. The light of faith ignited the disciples' hearts, and they felt it burning as Jesus gave them a short course on salvation history. Moses and the prophets all pointed and referred to Jesus of Nazareth as the Savior of All. He is God.

And the disciples then remarked that their hearts were aflame when Jesus interpreted the Scriptures and spoke to them along the way. Such burning hearts we need to have and to nurture as we continually converse and talk to Jesus as we walk our path.

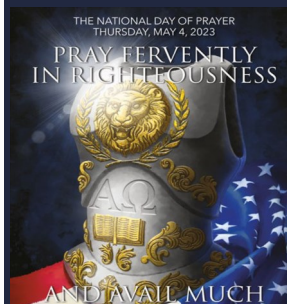

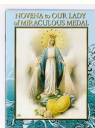
Mother's Day Novena

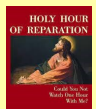

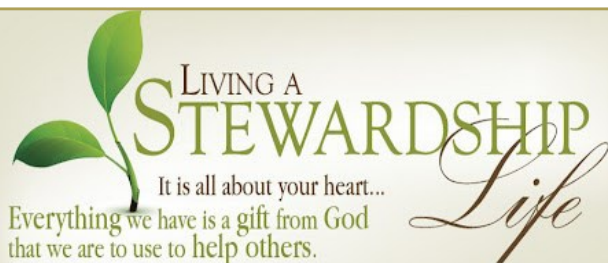
Phil Thompson is being ordained a deacon on Saturday May 20, 2023 at the Cathedral in Trenton!

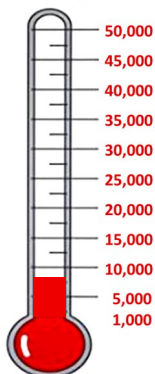

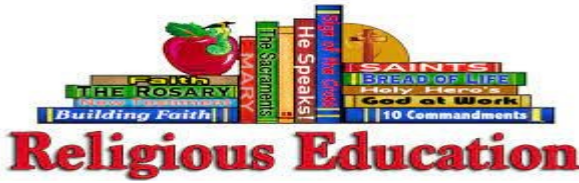

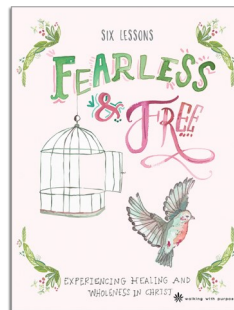
