
Notes from Father PJ



"Ave Maria:" May is the Month of Mary, our Blessed Mother by Bishop O'Connell

Hail Mary, full of Grace, the Lord is with thee. Blessed art thou among women and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

Most Catholics have learned and recited this prayer from their earliest days. It is a beautiful prayer that affirms the nature of our relationship with the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of God and Mother of the Church. It saddens me greatly when I visit with young school children – and even some adults –and they don't know that prayer or, worse, don't seem to understand "why" Catholics say it.

St. Bernard of Clairvaux (1090-1153) was a French Cistercian monk, theologian, preacher and reformer in the early Middle Ages who was well known – among many things – for his great devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary. He authored the Marian prayer so familiar to us known as The *Memorare* and numerous other homilies, hymns, and treatises about her. In *De Maria*, he famously wrote, "numquam satis" ... "about Mary, never enough (can be said)."

Love for Mary, the Blessed Mother of the Lord Jesus Christ, is as natural to the Catholic as love for one's own mother. Mary is, after all, the mother of the Lord and he is, at once, our Savior and our brother. "We never give more honor to Jesus than when we give honor to his mother, and we honor her simply and solely to honor him all the more perfectly. We go to her only as a way leading to the goal we seek, Jesus her Son" (St. Louis Marie de Montfort). We worship him as God. We love her as his mother. 




