# Notes from Fr PJ

Dear Friends in Christ,

Peace!

"My dear brothers and sisters in Christ, on this blessed Trinity Sunday, we gather together to reflect upon the profound mystery of the Holy Trinity, a truth that lies at the very heart of our faith. The doctrine of the Holy Trinity reveals to us the nature of God, and invites us to contemplate the beauty and richness of His divine love.



In our human experience, we encounter the concept of unity in various ways. We witness it in our families, our communities, and our relationships. But the unity we find in the Holy Trinity surpasses all human understanding. God is one, and yet He exists in three distinct persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. This mystery challenges us to expand our minds and hearts, to embrace the limitless dimensions of God's love.

The Father, the Creator of all things, out of His boundless love, sent His Son, Jesus Christ, into the world to save us from sin and reconcile us with Himself. The Son, who is fully God and fully human, willingly took on our frailty, walked among us, and offered Himself as the perfect sacrifice on the cross. Through His death and resurrection, He redeemed us and restored our relationship with the Father.

And let us not forget the Holy Spirit, the Advocate and Comforter, who dwells within us, guiding and empowering us on our journey of faith. The Spirit breathes life into the Church, unifying and equipping us to be the hands and feet of Christ in the world. The Spirit's presence in our lives reminds us that we are never alone, for God is constantly at work within us, transforming us into the image of His Son.

The mystery of the Holy Trinity teaches us that God is a communion of love. Love is not a solitary act; it is relational and dynamic. The Father, Son, and Holy Spirit eternally pour themselves out for one another in perfect love. This divine love overflows from the Trinity and embraces all of creation. It beckons us to enter into a communion of love with God and with one another, imitating the selflessness and sacrificial nature of the Holy Trinity.

As we strive to understand the Holy Trinity, let us also recognize that we can never fully comprehend the depth of this mystery. Our finite minds can only grasp a glimpse of the divine reality. Yet, it is precisely in embracing this mystery with humility and awe that our faith is deepened and our hearts are opened to the wonders of God's love.

Today, as we celebrate Trinity Sunday, let us ponder the mystery of the Holy Trinity and its implications for our lives. May we grow in our love for God, recognizing His presence in every aspect of our existence. And may we reflect the unity and love of the Holy Trinity in our relationships, reaching out to others with compassion, forgiveness, and reconciliation.

May the grace of the Father, the mercy of the Son, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with us always. Amen."

If you have been reading this far, you might have realized that that homily was beautifully written and wonderfully crafted. I did not write that. It was from Artificial Intelligence.

I texted my iPhone and asked for a homily this Trinity Sunday and voila, in two seconds, I got the homily (where I put quotation marks in this letter). Whatever is fed to the computer world in this wide encyclopedia of knowledge and information is proportional to its output.

Now, our human intelligence cannot be in any way artificial. God has provided us with the wisdom and knowledge to know Him, love Him and serve Him.

May we not be hindered by the artificiality of this world, therefore, but rely more on the naturalness of God's love and mercy for us, which is the core message of Trinity Sunday.

John 3:16—no artificiality, just pure humility and God's relentless search for us and our life with Him forever.

# We Are Called To Develop and Serve

## Eucharistic Procession in celebration of The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

**WHERE:** St. Joseph's Church, Toms River

**WHEN:** on the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ or  
Corpus Christi Sunday, June 11 following 12 Noon Mass.

**WHAT & WHY:** A Eucharistic Procession, just like Eucharistic Adoration, is an extension of the worship of Jesus Christ, truly present in the Blessed Sacrament. The supreme act of adoration and the source and summit of the Christian life is the celebration of the Mass, and that celebration is prolonged and intensified through Eucharistic worship outside of the Mass. In Eucharistic Processions, the missionary aspect of the Eucharist is emphasized as we go forth into the world. Not only gazing upon our Eucharistic Lord, but walking with him, we experience what the disciples did 2000 years ago as they walked with Jesus, proclaiming the Good News to the world. A parish community that undertakes a Eucharistic Procession has made the decision to publicly proclaim its belief in Jesus' True Presence in the Eucharist. By this public witness of faith, the parish invites people in the community to encounter the Risen Lord present in the Eucharistic Host. (excerpt from "Eucharistic Processions" published by the Knights of Columbus). All are invited to participate. We will be processing down Hooper Ave, through Washington Street and down Main Street to Huddy Park (approx. 1 mile) where we will have a short worship and prayer experience. We will then process back to St Joseph's Church and conclude with benediction around 3:00PM. Parish ministries are encouraged to bring banners. This year Corpus Christi, as well, marks the beginning of the second year of the National Eucharistic Revival – the year of the Parish.
