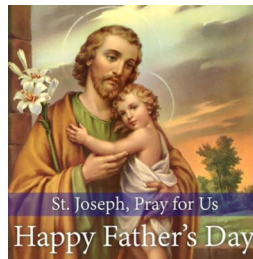

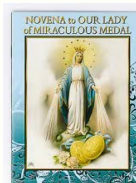


Father's Day Novena

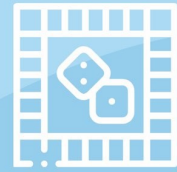
May Crowning and Rosary Procession was held in the Church on May 20 after the 4PM Mass. Thank you to all those who attended to honor Mary, our Mother!
