

Notes from Fr PJ

Dear Friends in Christ,

Peace. Allow me to share with you the homily I gave last Sunday during the celebration of our 60th Anniversary as a parish family community.

We remember. "Remember" was the word Moses used in the Book of Deuteronomy. Remember how for forty years the Lord has directed all your journeying in the desert. Remember how during those forty years the Lord, your God, tested you by affliction and find out whether or not it was your intention to keep his commandments. Remember how you were afflicted with hunger, only to show you that it is by every word that comes forth from the mouth of the Lord that we live, and not by bread alone.



Remember.

Some of the people did. But some of them forgot. Some of them, when tested by affliction, did not keep his commandments. Some of them lived on bread alone, forgetting the words that came forth from the mouth of God. And, some of them, who did forget, were like the seeds that fell among thorny grounds. They withered and died.

Today, at the celebration of our Jubilee Mass, we remember. Our sixty years of existence as a parish family community is a timely reflection of our past. Our history is rooted from the seeds sown by parishioners who remained faithful to Saint Veronica Parish, and from the spiritual guidance of our clergy. Our journey as a parish has its ups and downs, as most of our journeys in life go and have gone. We had several openings and closings, triumphs and challenges, successes and setbacks.

We do remember. That is why we celebrate.

Celebrate.

Each day that the Mass is said in our Church, we celebrate. Each day that our priests consecrate the Body and Blood of Jesus, we celebrate. Each time that we receive Communion, we do celebrate.

We celebrate God's gift to us in the person of Jesus Christ, our Savior, the Word of God. We celebrate God's graces upon us and our families through the sacraments and through our constant prayers and unyielding devotions. We celebrate God's love and blessings in our lives with whatever we give, and to whomever we share.

We celebrate because we believe.

Believe.

We do believe.

We believe in the words of Jesus, who always keeps His promised. We believe in the words of our Lord, when He said that He is the living bread that came down from heaven. Whoever eats this bread will never die. We believe that we will only have life if we eat His Bread and drink His cup. He will remain with us and will raise us up on the last day. We do believe.

Celebrating our anniversary as a parish, henceforth, is an examination of our lives as a parish family community. We need to take time for greater fellowship and building new relationships, as parishioners of old have done in the past. The experiences of the past should lead us to a broader understanding of our spiritual family relationships, and a wider understanding of our faith journey experiences. Commemorating our shared faith and traditions now should usher in a deeper engagement and involvement in our parish ministries and religious organizations.

Otherwise, we could lose what is there to remember. Otherwise, we could no longer recall what is there to celebrate. Otherwise, we could forget Who is there to believe.

Through the intercession of Saint Veronica, our patroness, may we continually bear and share the Face of Christ, the Bread of Life. Amen.




