

Notes from Fr PJ

Dear Friends in Christ,

Peace!

Jesus, in this weekend's Gospel, sets before us reasons for fearlessness. "Fear no one", those are the first words he spoke to the Twelve today. And why should we not fear, according to our Lord.

First, eventually at the end in heaven, everything will be clear and will stand in the light. Nothing will be hidden and in the dark. Fear is afraid of the light, because the light exposes the truth of our actions and deeds. It needs darkness, because it is only in darkness that our fears are hidden and our secrets are kept. Truth sets us free. Jesus, the Light of the world, bids us to love the light. It exposes the darkness within us.

Secondly, the worst evil that can be done to us in this life is to kill our souls. No matter what evils are done to us in this life, no one can kill our immortal soul. God does not put anyone in hell. Nor can the devil send us to hell, without our consent and against our will. The good Lord has time and again given us directions/commands/pleas to be with Him in heaven. And, if God is for us, who can be against us (Rom 8:31)?

Thirdly, we are precious to our heavenly Father. We are precious more than all the sparrows in the world, or in the entire universe, or galaxies. God's love is total. He loves us more than we probably love ourselves.

And finally, there is no reason for fearlessness if we acknowledge Jesus. When we do so, the Father will acknowledge us. If we love Jesus, the Father will love us.



We, the Parish Family of Saint Veronica, are called through Baptism to proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ in faith, hope and love.


We strive toward deeper conversion by active participation in the Eucharist and by being good stewards to one another.



All tuition must be paid in full by Dec.15, 2023. You must have a Parish Soft online giving account to set up a payment plan through our payment portal.




