Notes from Fr PJ

Dear Friends in Christ,

Peace!

Let's backtrack a little bit.

Two weeks ago, we heard from the Gospel of Matthew the list of the Twelve Apostles. Jesus commissioned them to go out among the people, and to teach and heal. Last week, they were told not to fear anyone or anything. (If you happened to read my letter last week, I also listed there reasons why we should not fear. But if you were away, I'll just summarize it in one sentence—God loves each one of us immensely, and if we love Jesus in return as He loves us, then there is no reason to fear).

This week, Jesus is challenging us about our worthiness to love our Lord, based on how we feel about our family members. Now, that's quite a challenge. I could just hear some of us asking, "Does that mean, Jesus, that I should not love my father or mother? Does that mean, Jesus, that I should not love my son or daughter?" Nope, Jesus did not tell us that way. He added the words—more than me. We should love our family members, as we should. But, and here's the big but, not more than Jesus.

Nothing and no one should get in the way of loving and prioritizing Jesus. This is the spiritual order of priorities—Jesus, Others, You. J.O.Y., as the initials line up. Keeping them in order is the norm, not just the ideal. Disordering them leads to an abnormality. "Others" could mean other people, and so, when others are prioritized more than Jesus, then there is no J.O.Y., but O.J.Y. And how about the egotists and the self-absorbed? Again, no J.O.Y.. It could be Y.J.O. or Y.O.J. (the saddest inversion).




