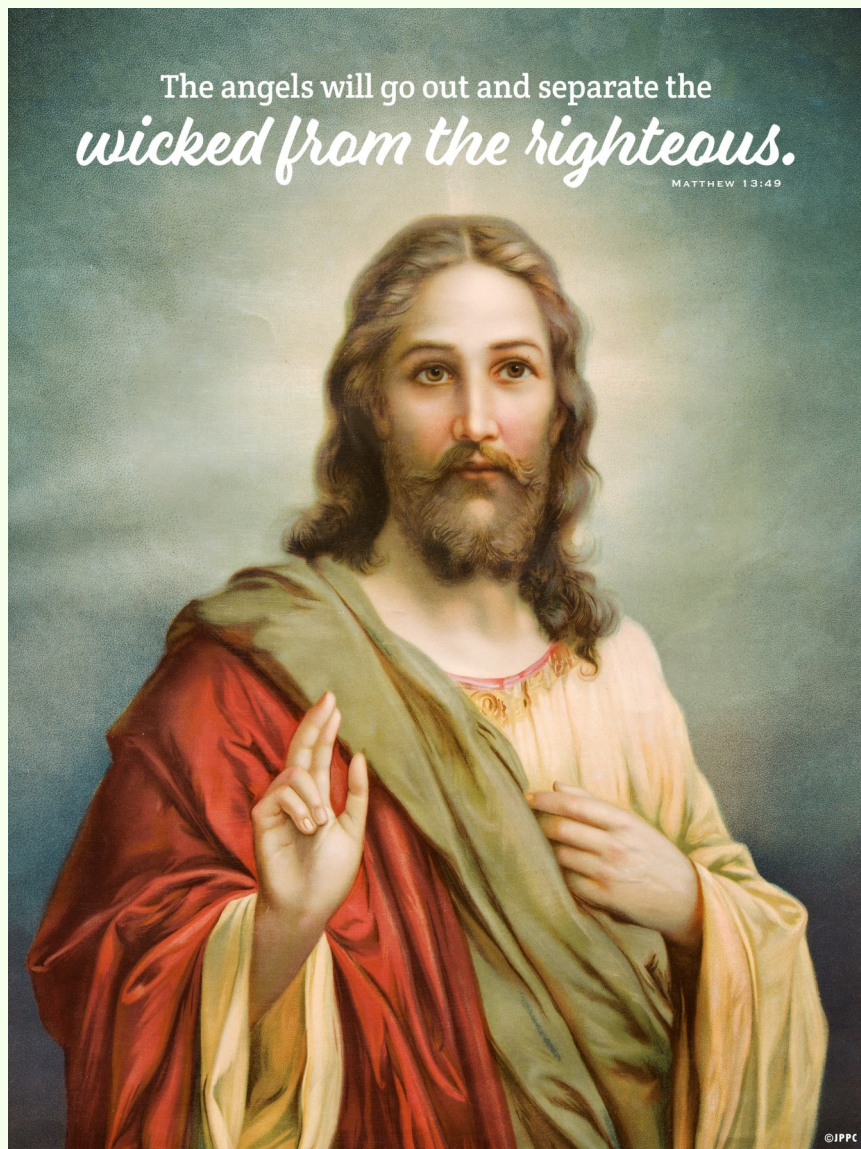

Notes from Fr PJ

Dear Friends in Christ,

Peace!

Romans 8:28—that was the first verse proclaimed by our Reader this weekend during the Second Reading. Saint Paul wrote to the Christian Community in Rome, "we know that all things work for good for those who love God, who are called according to his purpose."

I have memorized that passage and have given that verse to a number of people. Just the words—all things work for good for those who love God—are words of hope, encouragement and inspiration. We do love God, no questions about that. And therefore, even in the face of conflict, discouragement and upsetting news sometimes, things—all things—will work for good.

Easy to say. Harder to believe. Easily believable for "simple" things. How about terrible tragedies and life-changing events? They also love God, but why is it that things did not work for their good?

Saint Paul is not saying that "all thing things work for good" for everybody. It did not happen to Judas, who also loved God at one point. It happens only for those who love God, and who trust him. Loving and trusting God go together. We cannot love someone we cannot trust, just as we cannot trust someone we cannot love.

So, what does God want to give us? Nothing but our good. What is that "good" you are talking about, Fr. PJ? It is the good that God desires and wants the most for us. It is the good that God is continually calling us and challenging us to be better than we are.

It is the best, the truest, the deepest good in the end—heaven, which we all desire and pray to be a permanent resident there someday.

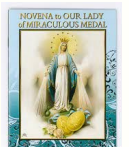

The Vatican grants plenary indulgence for St. Thomas Aquinas Jubilee celebrations

St. Thomas Aquinas' legacy will be commemorated in a special double jubilee by the Vatican. The celebration coincides with the 700th year since his canonization and his 800th birthday, promising the faithful a rare reward: a plenary indulgence which offers the possibility of lessening the temporal effects of sin. The Dominican Order, Aquinas' own, will lead the celebrations.

The proceedings commenced with a Mass at Fossanova Abbey, Italy, led by Cardinal Marcello Semeraro on July 18, 2023. On March 7, 2024, the Dominican Order will honor the 750th anniversary of Aquinas' death at the same location. The jubilee will culminate on the feast of St. Thomas Aquinas on Jan. 28, 2025, the 800th anniversary of Aquinas' birth.

To earn the indulgence, the faithful are encouraged to visit Dominican-affiliated holy sites. Participation in the jubilee celebrations or engaging in personal prayer and reflection can earn the indulgence. The usual conditions for a plenary indulgence also include being in a state of grace, having an aversion to sin, and praying for the Pope's intentions. Confession and Communion are part of the conditions. The indulgence extends to those housebound due to age, illness or other serious reasons, if they spiritually engage with the jubilee events. This indulgence can also be applied "to the souls of the faithful departed still in purgatory."

"May our celebration of the double jubilee in the life of St. Thomas propel us to serve God and the Church with great dedication and profound humility,"
