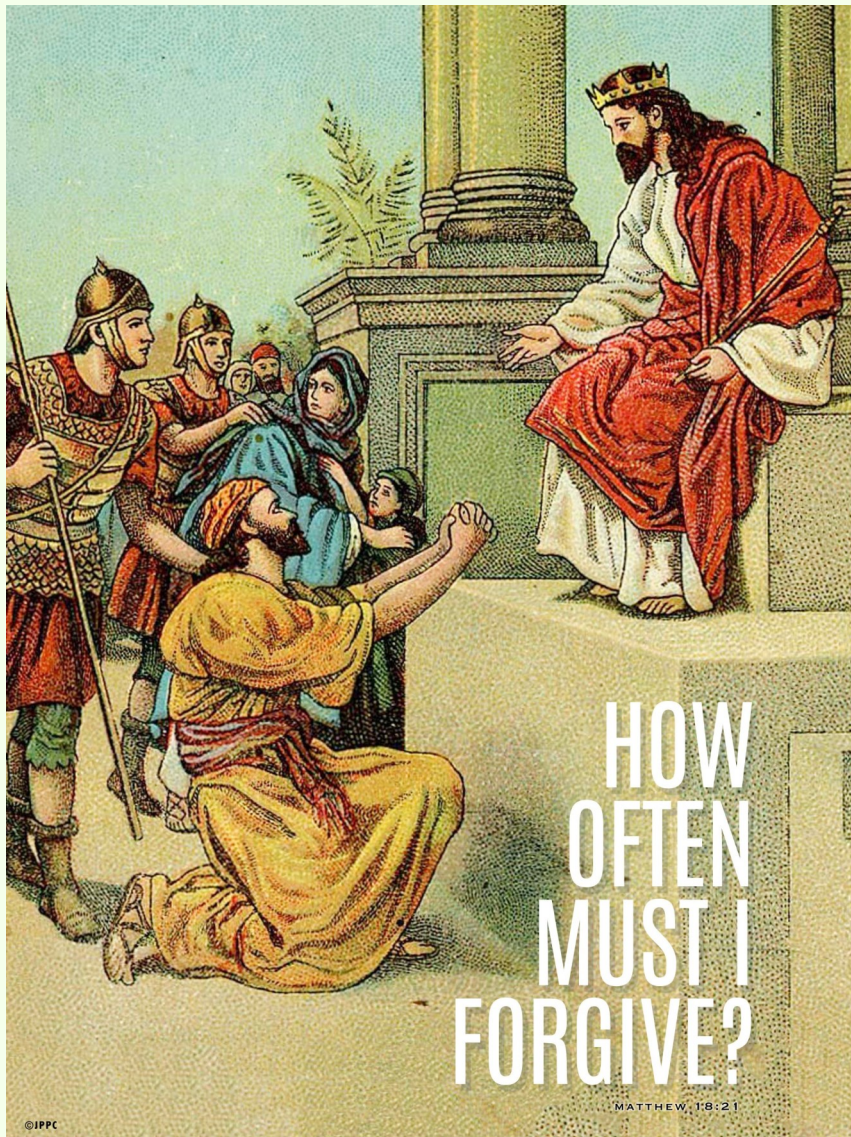

Dear Friends in Christ,

Peace!

We live in an imperfect world.

Expectations crumble. Promises are broken. Relationships get shattered.

We hope to live, however, fingers crossed and hearts united with the Cross of Jesus, in a place that is perfect. We pray that we would all be someday in heaven, where God dwells. It is forever and the perfection will have no end. We will be with God, who created all that is and we are. We will be with Jesus, who loved us then and is loving us still.

In spite of our own imperfections, weaknesses, and sins against Him and His loved ones—people we like, live for, and love (also, people we do not wish working for, we do not intend living with, those we do not like, or maybe hate), God is always stretching his hands in granting us forgiveness and mercy.

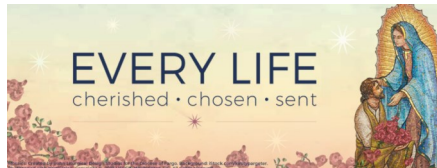
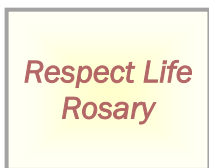
Is there anyone in your life right now that you need to forgive? If you do, you might have been carrying that burden for a number of years now, when would you be able to forgive?
