Dear Friends in Christ,

May you have the peace of Christ in your hearts and with your loved ones!

I will be remiss somehow in my other ministry as the Mission Director of the Diocese of Trenton if I do not share with you the following message about World Mission Sunday.

“Every year, something special happens on the next-to-last Sunday of October.

WORLD MISSION SUNDAY joins all Catholics of the world into one community of faith. At Mass that Sunday, we recommit ourselves to our common vocation,

- through Baptism to be missionaries,
- through prayer,
- participation in the Eucharist,
- and by giving generously to the collection for the Society for the Propagation of the Faith.

Pope Francis’ message for World Mission Sunday this year reflects on the theme: “We cannot but speak about what we have seen and heard” (Acts 4:20). He reminds us that, “as Christians, we cannot keep the Lord to ourselves,” as we “recall with gratitude all those men and women who by their testimony of life help us to renew our baptismal commitment to be generous and joyful apostles of the Gospel.”

On World Mission Sunday, we join our Holy Father in supporting his missions. As we pray and respond here at home, and at our grace-filled Church of St. Veronica’s in Howell, we share in those celebrations taking place in every parish and school throughout the world. Together, through our prayers and financial support, we bring the Lord’s mercy and concrete help to the most vulnerable communities in the Pope’s missions.

In a world where so much divides us, World Mission Sunday rejoices in our unity as missionaries by our Baptism, as it offers each one of us an opportunity to support the life-giving presence of the Church among the poor and marginalized in more than 1,111 mission dioceses.”

Being part of the Mission Family has helped and enhanced my priestly ministry. It is the spirit of giving generously and cheerfully that has strengthened me throughout all these years. I have been a recipient of those gifts, ever since I entrusted my life to our Lord. And to say the least, what a gift it is to be a priest. What a blessing it is to work and share myself for the missions.

I ask you to please respond generously with prayer, financial support and participation in the Eucharist as your means allow, especially during this World Mission Sunday.

Life is Beautiful


The 40 Days for Life is a campaign of prayer and fasting for an end to abortion here in America, from Sept 22 to Oct 31.

Since its inception in 2007, 19,198 babies have been saved, 221 abortion workers have quit, and 112 abortion centers have closed. 40 Days for Life also involves prayerful, peaceful witnessing in front of an abortion clinic.

People simply say the Rosary or other prayers for one hour while walking along the sidewalk. Here in Monmouth, the site is the Planned Parenthood facility at 69 E. Newman Springs Rd in Shrewsbury. We staff each Wednesday Sept 22 to Oct 31 from 8 AM to 6 PM.





Next Youth Group Meeting is November 7th from 1 to 3:30 p.m. in the cafeteria.



There are approximately 2200 registered active parishioner households in the parish. If the remaining 1912 parishioner households contributed even \$25 each by the end of the year, the parish would far exceed its goal of \$95,000 and receive a 15% or \$14,250 rebate from the Diocese of Trenton.

For all donations in excess of our goal, the parish will receive a 50% rebate! This means that for every \$100 donated over our goal, the parish will receive \$50. This could add up to a huge bonus for the Parish while at the same time providing funds to the Diocese for critical programs.

Each intention is \$10.




Join our Men's Group Sunday Morning


Prayer Shawl Ministry
