

Notes from Fr. PJ

Dear Friends in Christ,

Peace!

We're getting near the end.

Not the end of the world, because it is only God the Father who knows when it is going to happen. But, the end of the liturgical year. We transition to Year A two weeks from now with the First Sunday of Advent. Next week, we'll celebrate the Solemnity of Christ the King, considered in the Church as the last Sunday in Ordinary Time.



However, the First Reading from the prophet Malachi is quite unsettling. He says, "the day is coming blazing like an oven when all the proud and all evildoers will be stubble..." Jesus, our good Lord and Savior, presented more troubling images: temples being destroyed, false messiahs and kingdoms at war with one another. There will be earthquakes and plagues. There will even be problems within families until the end.

Some of us might consider that the things that Jesus predicted have already been happening. And there is one feeling that seems common to all of us—fear. There is the everyday fear of losing our health, or the fear of misfortune coming to our family. There is the fear of being rejected and unwanted. There is also the fear of being left alone, without friends, or family, or loved ones, as we move into old age.

Then, there's the fear of losing our mobility, of losing our independence and sanity, the loss that we call death.

We are not alone. There are so many of us, who are afraid. There are still other fears that creep in and stalk us—fears that we usually do not express outright: the fear of losing control, the fear of blaming ourselves in unfortunate and sad situations. Questions may haunt some of us: Why couldn't I have done more as a parent? Why couldn't I have spent more time with my loved ones? Why couldn't I have expressed more my love, care and affection to my family?" They are fears based on regrets and hounded by guilt.

Faith is the opposite of fear. Jesus says in the Gospel this weekend that "not a hair of your head will be destroyed. By your perseverance you will secure your lives." Keep moving. Keep persevering. Keep looking up.

The end may or may not be near to some of us. But, call out. Call on Jesus the Christ. He loves us immensely. This we all know and believe. This we also hope, that we all end in Him. For with Jesus, our world and our soul will have no end.






Candle Light Remembrance Mass


CHURCH LIGHTING CAMPAIGN & SPONSORSHIP







We will be raffling a Fire pit set and selling pins, magnets after each Mass on November 12th and 13th. Please support this worthy cause and help those who protect our Freedoms.


