Notes from Fr. P.J

10 December 2022

Dear Friends in Christ,

Peace!

Okay, now, for those of us who were able to read my letter last week, here's the continuation of the story. (What's the story?)

John the Baptist, whom Jesus himself called the greatest of the prophets, had some doubts. So he sent his disciples to Jesus with the question, "Are you the one who is to come, or should we look for another?" John was in prison at that time.

I have celebrated Mass to inmates in prison halls, but I have never been to their prison cells. Movies depict them as dark and sometimes windowless. Only the cell's barring, steel, or metal doors serves as an exit to the world of the living. In this terrible place where John the Baptist was, we could appreciate the fact that even the best among us would have some doubts about God or about his love and existence.

The very first expression of doubt happened in the garden of Eden. The tempter introduced doubt into the mind of Eve when he asked, "Did God actually say, 'You shall not eat of any tree in the garden'?" Doubt became the devil's tool in shaking Eve's confidence and trust in what God said.

Other cases of doubt in the Bible? There's Zechariah, who the angel told that he would have a son in his old age. "That's not possible. I'm too old for that," he must have thought. He would be mute until the day he wrote the name of his son, John, on a tablet (the same John the Baptist we have in this letter). God is above all human endeavors and reasoning. This truth is what we sometimes forget. Sinful doubt may result whenever we allow our humanity to pre-empt our faith in our good Lord.

Have faith. Believe.

That is our response to this incredible and unthinkable story about God-made man. God, who created the heavens and who has no beginning and no end, became part of us—a human being in the person of Jesus Christ—fully human and fully divine. 50-50. Nothing more with being a man, nothing less with being a God.

Jesus answered John with facts and miraculous deeds, not words, "The blind regained their sight, the lame walked, lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the poor have the good news proclaimed to them." You can argue with words but not with deeds.

There you have it, dear friends. Most of us have witnessed and seen miraculous deeds before our eyes in our own lifetimes. We are ourselves God's miracle each day. If you ask me whether I have any doubts and need to hear the story, I'll tell you that we'll listen to it together (and hopefully progress in spirituality and holiness because of it).

It is the story of Jesus. It is the story of Emmanuel —God with us. It is the story of Christmas.

Have a blessed Advent!
