

### **Letter from Fr PJ**

This was Fr PJ's message that was posted in our Flock note newsletter last week.

Dear Friends in Christ,

Peace from Bangladesh!

"Extreme poverty to rise in Bangladesh, inflation to hit 9% by Fiscal Year 2024" was the headline of The Business Standard, the country's leading English newspaper. It was my first day in the eighth most populous country in the world (173 million).



Now, I did not mention the above to analyze their financial data or offer any advice. I am just wondering what could lead them to poverty considering the trove of arable and fertile soil they have. It is beyond my capacity to judge them for their wherewithal in a field where I am not capable or competent.

What unfolded before the day was over seemed to provide some of the answers to my wonderment.

Fr. David, my host and the Bishop's Chancellor of the Diocese of Barisal, picked me up that morning. He rented a car for the entire week of my stay, since he does not own one. Only the Bishop does.

Just a quarter through our four hour ride to his parish, we were flagged down by four traffic enforcers. They told our driver that he was over-speeding, which in my own speeding vocabulary — he was not. Under the heat of the searing noonday sun and after pleading his case, our poor driver relented, gave them close to \$50 dollars in return to his license not being confiscated.

He was very careful this time after the incident, minding the speedometer. An hour later — yep, you guessed it right. Another flag down, another 30 minute negotiation, another baking and broiling in the heat. It was 100 degrees Fahrenheit at that time, as my Weather App showed (and some of my body fats had slowly melted away).

Our driver lost another 50 dollars to the enforcers and they confiscated his license this time.

Not all these enforcers are corrupt, that's for sure. But, from what I witnessed on my first day here — there needs to be a major overhaul of the core beliefs and morals.

Fr David had planned to go again to the capital city, Dakka, on Friday in order for me to meet the Maryknoll Sisters and the Missionaries of Charity. I asked him not to, since I think these same enforcers will again be on the road flagging down a compact size, white Toyota as they calculate and pile up their spending money for the coming feast of Eid Al Fitr.

On this Divine Mercy Sunday, we continually pray for repentance, reconciliation and yes, mercy for our poverty to see what is right and good and true, for the super inflation of our egos that tend to forget the Divine.

You are in my thoughts and prayers. Take care and regards, Fr. PJ

Divine Mercy is when God's love meets us and helps us in the midst of our suffering and sin. It's always the Lord stepping out in compassion to help us poor, weak, and broken sinners. From our perspective, then, every good we receive is an expression Divine Mercy.






