Notes from Fr. PJ

Dear Friends in Christ,

Peace and Joy!

How did we know, really know and also understand, that Jesus Christ rose from the dead?

May I present to you three reasons why:

1. Somebody told me about it. They were the first century witnesses who said Jesus is alive after being dead. Their stories were recounted through generations and compiled in what we now call the New Testament. I believe what they said, and I know they would never lie. They were the minority then.
2. The resurrection of our Lord has stood the test of time. A lot of things start off good but soon fizzle out. Fame fades, fads and fashions go. Only the real thing stands the test of time. As long as there is life on earth, there will be people like you and me talking about the resurrection of Jesus Christ, talking about Easter Sunday.
3. I believe in the resurrection, because I have experienced it (and I love it). The first century disciples had difficulty explaining it at first, but had it easier when they felt it. The best proof of the resurrection is not in what they witnessed, but in how they responded to what they saw, on how Jesus rising from the dead changed them for the better. It made them courageous, brave and zealous in talking about our Lord, even to the point of martyrdom and death.



The real power of Easter is not in its great hymns, the lilies and the flowers adorning the sanctuary, or the great Hallelujah chorus. It is in ways that our lives are moved from death to life, from a sealed tomb to an open doorway, from despair to hope.

That is Easter. That is Resurrection. And truly, Christ is risen! Alleluia!

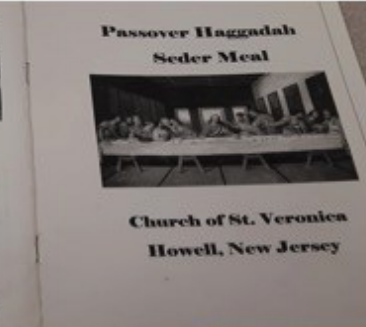

More trees and bushes will be planted this spring.

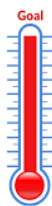

Add additional spot lighting to Stations of the Cross. This work is still being priced out. Repairs, labor and parts are estimated at approximately \$20,000.

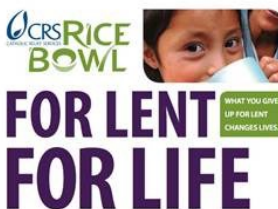

Your input and expertise is needed so planning can begin. An Event committees are being formed.

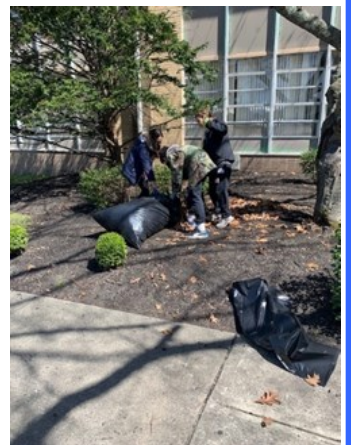

Twenty-five adult parishioners, parish staff, St Veronica youth, and Boy Scout Troop 300 members worked together to accomplish the following project saving the parish thousands of dollars in spring landscaping & clean-up costs:

- Continued clearing the fence line from the rectory to the field of vines and leaves
- Picked up the leaves along the field fence across from the rectory and school
- Pulled out the dead mums in front of the church and at the school entrance
- Cut back dead plants/flowers at church steps
- Weeded at the grotto
- Picked up sticks by side of church.
- Blew out, raked up and removed leaves and weeds at church garden areas and grassy area of fire lane
- Cut down dying tree from side of church
- Blew out and removed leaves from school entrance
- Raked up and removed pine cones from under the trees across from convent
- Cleared dirt from curb collecting in front of and blocking the drainage trench

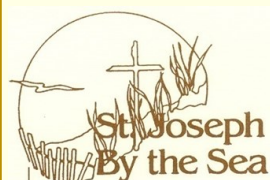
