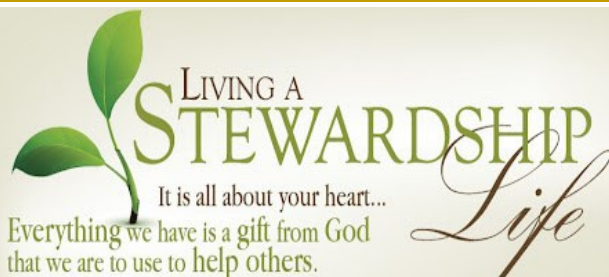

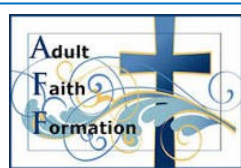

What are Eucharistic Miracles?

Eucharistic miracles are meant to confirm our faith in the true presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, which is based on Jesus's words according to which what seems like bread is no longer bread, and what seems wine is no longer wine. In the Eucharistic miracles the flesh and blood - or one or the other - appear, depending on the situation. The purpose of these miracles is to show that we must not look at the external appearance (bread and wine) but at the substance, to the true reality of the thing, which is flesh and blood.

The Lord performs these miracles to give us a sign, easy and visible to all, that in the Eucharist there is the true body and true blood of the Lord.



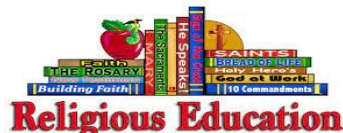

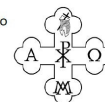
