

Divine Mercy Sunday is celebrated on the Second Sunday of Easter, April 24

Divine Mercy Sunday is based on the private revelations of St. Faustina Kowalska who was canonized by St. Pope John Paul II in 2000 at which time the devotional practices were already popular in many communities. Among the practices associated with the devotion are its novena, the Chaplet of the Divine Mercy (a series of prayers organized similarly to a rosary), the Hour of Great Mercy (a time of prayer traditionally

celebrated at 3 p.m.), and the plenary indulgence granted to those who receive the Eucharist and celebrate reconciliation on Divine Mercy Sunday.

The Divine Mercy Novena began on Good Friday, April 15th, after the outdoor Stations of the Cross. The Novena will conclude Divine Mercy Sunday at 3PM..


