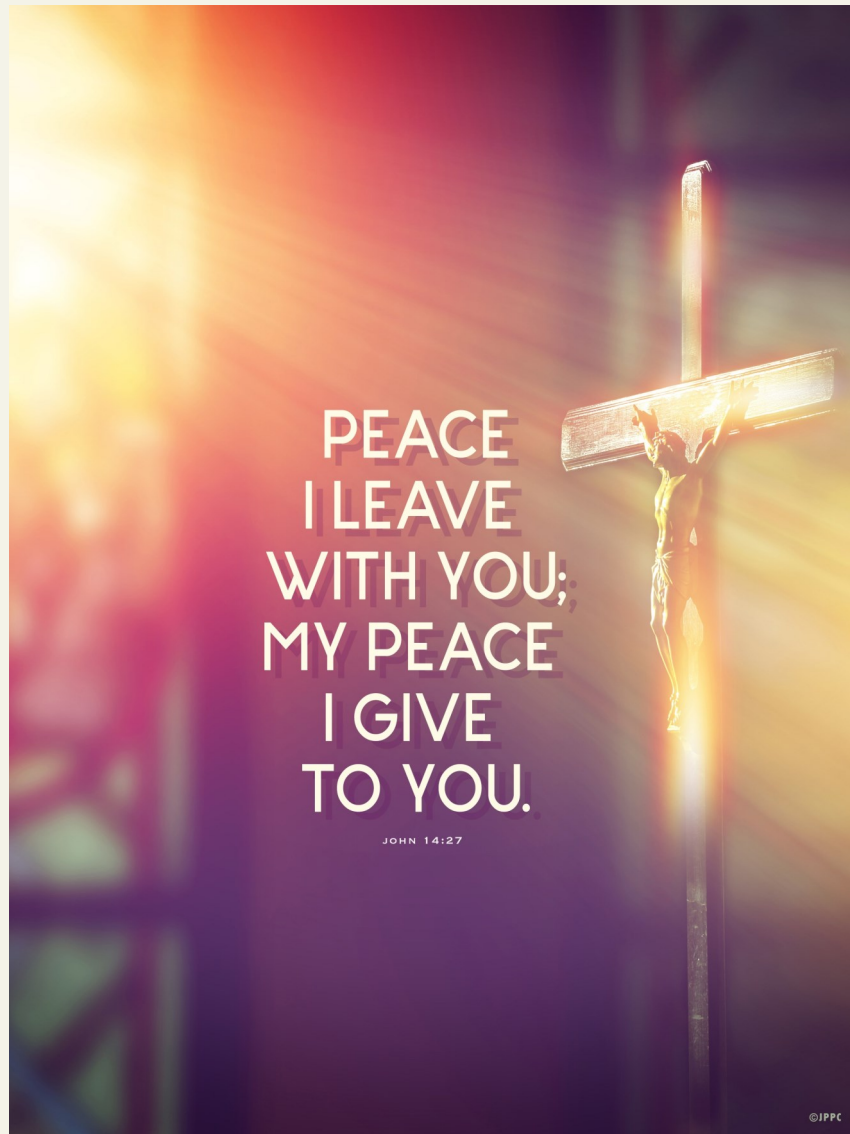

Notes from Fr. PJ

Dear Friends in Christ,

Peace be with you!

I find it difficult to write about peace, when all around us are images and news opposite to it. What we heard this past weekend about the killings and shootings in Buffalo, New York, a Church in California plus the war in Ukraine were stapled to our lives and activities.

Peace, as we all know it, is not just the absence of war, worries, anxieties or burdens. It is not the denial of our problems and pains. It is not a rejection of the ugly twin spirits of our times: boredom and temporary excitement.

Peace means a deeper trust in the good Lord, whom we believe and love. It is trust, that is an offspring of faith. It allows us to confide in Jesus our deepest secret, our worst fear, our unmanageable resentments and disappointments.

Peace—the first message announced by the angels after Jesus was born in Bethlehem. Peace—one of the last messages Jesus shared after He rose from the tomb.

Do trust in God, as in, really trust Him and His presence in our lives. Peace will be one of its fruits. Forgive and love, as our good Lord is telling us in the Gospel, and you will find the calmness and serenity that you desire. Perhaps, trusting in God and faith in His words may be lacking in our lives. Or maybe, there is a gaping hole in our hearts, where forgiveness is necessary. Or maybe, just maybe, we have not really exhausted ourselves in loving God and our fellow brothers and sisters, especially those close to us.

When life gives us discomfort and disappointment with all that is happening around us, when life gives us confusion in our own insecurities, when we do need answers to our questions, we need Someone. Or, somebody out there to just hold our hands and let us feel that we are not alone. There is a God. His name is Jesus. Our one God is the Father Almighty, the Incarnate Son and the Holy Spirit.

In most of our readings this Easter we might have noticed that Jesus does not come to us with an explanation. He comes to us with His presence.

May His presence in our lives give us the peace that we all need today and forever. Whew. That sounded easy writing those words. Now, let us take it into action.

- ◆ Time management—start and end on time; 90 minutes max

- ◆ Meet with parish program coordinator when necessary
- ◆ Most important is to be yourself, share faith authentically and let Christ lead you on an amazing path!

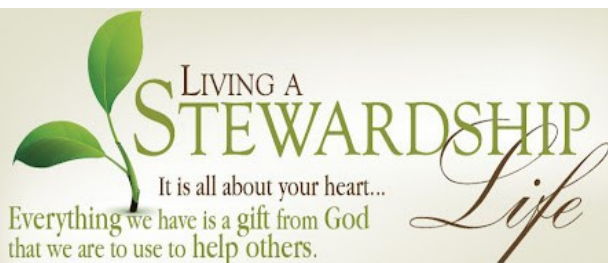

redbuds were planted next to the church. A pink dog



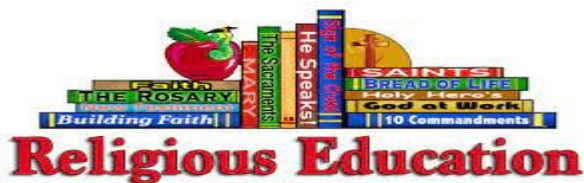
wood was also planted in
