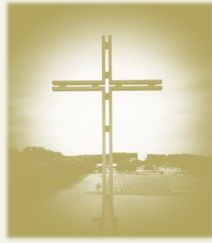

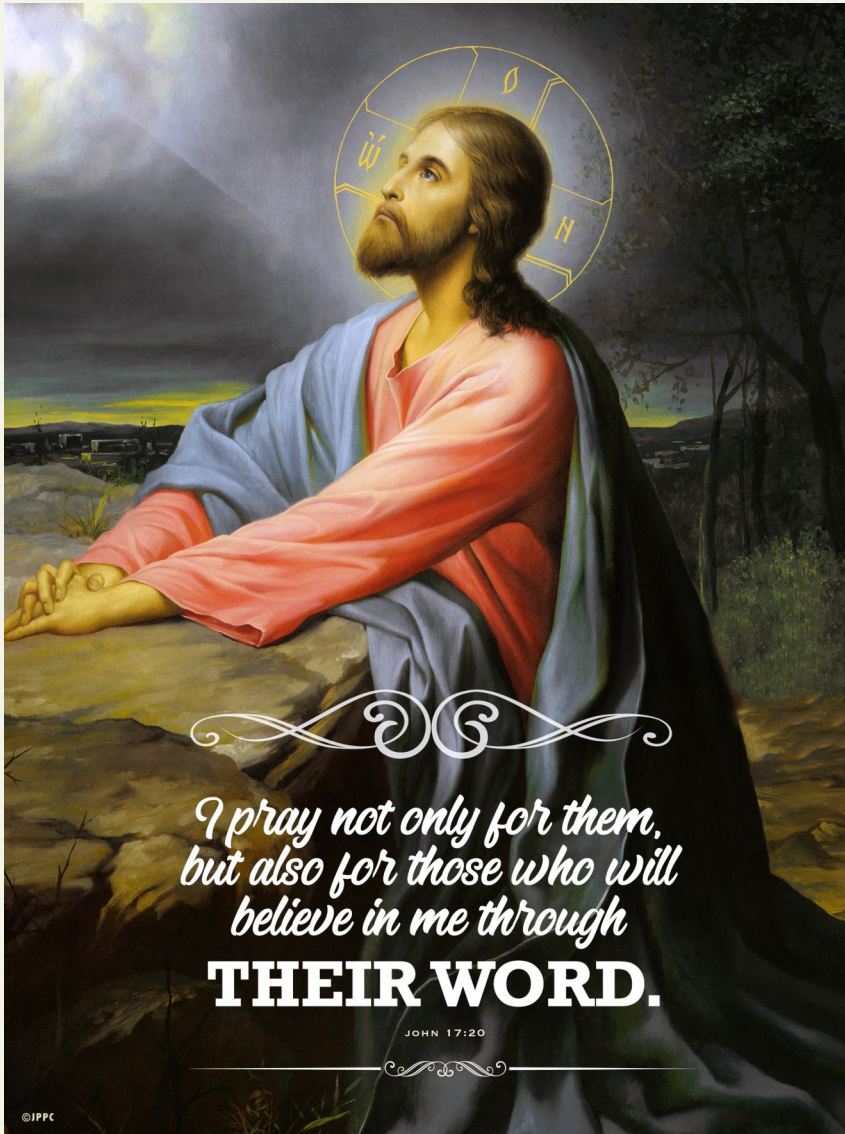

Parish Updates from the Business Manager

Dear Parishioners,

It has been more than a year since my first day on March 24, 2021. As I reported last year, in November 2021, in three weeks' stewardship reports, much has happened on the St Veronica Campus. First, I would like to once again take the opportunity to thank all the parishioners who have stepped forward giving their time and talent to help out in so many ways from volunteering in the parish office, to assessing our security concerns, to volunteering to clean up the parish grounds, to helping to plan the year-long fun-filled activities and events for St Veronica's 60th Anniversary Celebration which will take place from July 1, 2022-June 20, 2023.

I stepped up as business manager of the school in the beginning of the year after the closing was announced. A few things I have been working on (not reported in the bulletin) are: I have applied for Covid-19 reimbursement through FEMA for Covid disinfection & cleaning expenses incurred by the parish and the school. The first round of reimbursement awards totaled \$30,520. Much of the funds was used to pay unpaid invoices. The second round of reimbursement submitted last month was in the amount of \$64,522. Hopefully, this will be awarded soon. It will be used to cover closing costs of the school. This month, I have applied for Non-Profit Security Grant, NSGP, through the Office of Emergency Management, OEM. This is a very competitive grant, usually half of the applicants are awarded security funds. I'm optimistic! So, when these funds come through, it will be applied to security infrastructure making St Veronica even more safe and secure. The phase 2 security project will be the video surveillance system for the interior and exterior of the school & convent buildings. Funds will also be used for purchasing bollards, movable barricades to secure outdoor events and additional exterior lighting dark zones of our parking lot.

To date over \$45, 000 has been donated by you through the Special Projects Collection. Funds were used very wisely on these projects: Church & convent painting, tree removal, digital sign repairs, card access systems for the church. In May also your donations and the generous \$10,000 donation of a parishioner purchased the installation of our Phase 1 security upgrades: a new video surveillance system for the interior/exterior of the church building. Camera's were also added to the rectory and adoration chapel. If you would like to sponsor an upcoming project, please reach out to me. Recently, a parishioner offered to pay for the cracked luna glass in the adoration monstrance and a few weeks ago a parishioner offered to purchase new electric candles for the church. I am looking into the best options for that upgrade. *Thank you again for your generosity!* I announced in the bulletin that the next project would be church lighting upgrades, but a collapsed wall in one of our parking lot drainage dry wells has caused the parking lot to sink. This will be taken care next week. The 2nd phase of this project will be cleaning out the debris collected inside the other drywells around the property to prevent flooding. These areas also freeze in the winter causing hazard conditions. The digital sign is still awaiting parts to be at 100%. Thank you to Chris DiPasquale for all his efforts. John, our maintenance coordinator, has been doing a fine job taking care of the grounds and buildings. Please thank him for all his efforts when you see him. He has accomplished many projects since his arrival to SVC.

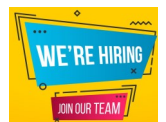

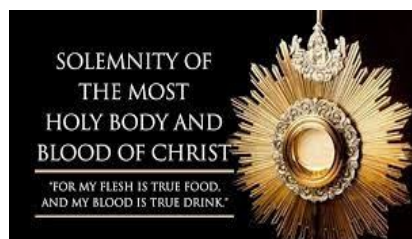

What better way to celebrate Father's Day than spending it with God, the Father Almighty! Come join St. Veronica's Parish community for the highly-anticipated return of our 2022 Corpus Christi Eucharistic Procession on June 19, 2022 immediately following the noon Mass on the Mall area. Experience the blessings of a Corpus Christi procession led by our pastor, Fr. PJ and our 2022 First Communicants. All 2022 Communicants are encouraged to join in the procession.

After the procession, we will continue the celebration in the school cafeteria with light refreshments.

Feast of Corpus Christi is also called Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. In the Roman Catholic Church, it is observed in honor of the real presence of the body (corpus) of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. The Feast of Corpus Christi originated in 1246 when Robert de Torote, bishop of Liège, ordered the feast to be celebrated in his diocese by St. Juliana, prioress of Mont Cornillon near Liège (1222-58). St. Juliana had experienced a vision. In 1264, Pope Urban IV ordered the whole church to observe the feast. In the 15th century Corpus Christi became one of the principal feasts of the church. The procession became the feast's most prominent feature.

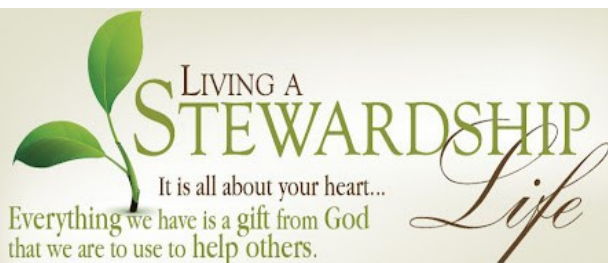

St. Veronica's May Crowning & Procession was held Sat., May 21 after the 4PM Mass.

Due to the extreme heat the Procession and Crowning was held inside the Church.

MINI-PLANTING EVENT held in Saturday, May 21 at STV

Not many turned out due to the heat but those who helped really did an amazing job to accomplish so much! SPECIAL THANK YOU to our parishioners, staff, RE volunteers and to TROOP 300 and their friends/siblings! Special thanks also to Spencer and Dan, Jr Troop 300 Leaders for taking the lead at each planting area (grotto and convent).

Considering the heat we accomplished so much in the 3 morning hours of the planting and clean-up:

Mary's grotto - weeded, split and planted daffodil bulbs from the church pots, planted marigolds along the edge of the beds, filled three planters with flowers, and mulched the area

Church: changed out the flowers in the four pillar planters

Office/Adoration Chapel: Planted hibiscus bushes in 2 planters at the entrance

Convent: Part one last year was removing overgrown shrubs. Part two this May included sprucing up beds around the convent. Weeds were pulled. In front of the convent, daffodils and daylilies were dug out from the circle with the infant of Prague statue, split and replanted. A new planting in the circle was created (half circles of daffodils and daylilies around the infant of Prague statue) Five azalea bushes from Easter were planted in the same circle. Five hydrangea bushes from Easter were planted at the convent entrance. Planters were filled and placed at the convent's main entrance.

All the areas were heavily watered.

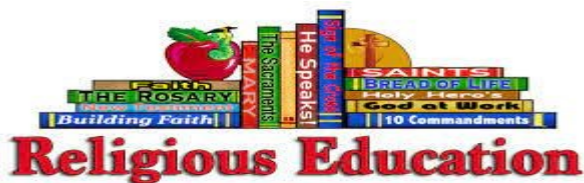

All 2022-2023 tuition must be paid in full by November 30, 2022. All registered RE Families are encouraged to create an online giving account to streamline this process.
