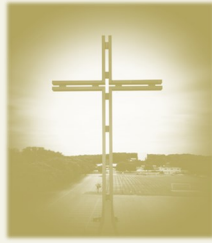

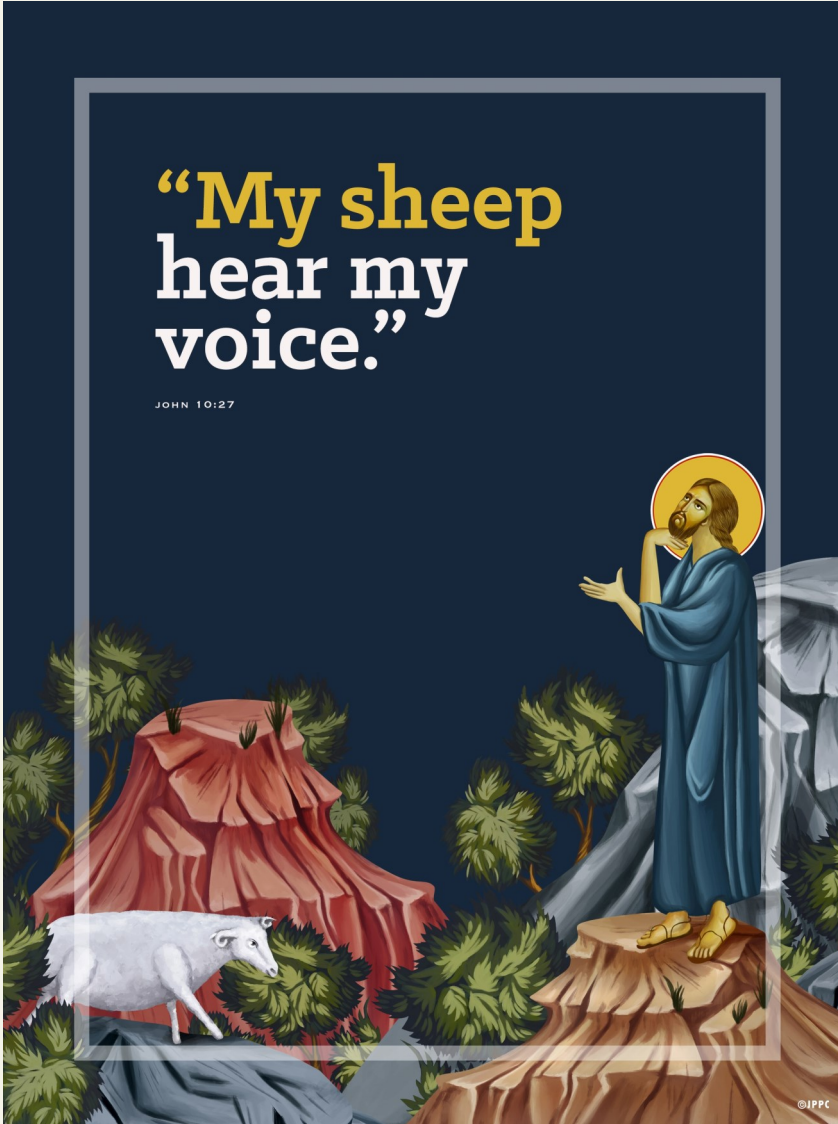

Notes from Fr. PJ

Dear Friends in Christ,

Peace and Blessings to you and your loved ones!

"Let it be, let it be-e, let it be, let it be, speaking words of wisdom, let it be," the Beatles once sang. Prior to those verses were the words, "When I found myself in times of trouble, Mother Mary comes to me, speaking words of wisdom, let it be." (I am humming as I write these notes).



Mary, the Mother of our Lord Jesus, is one of my mothers. Whenever I pray to her through the Holy Rosary, I know she is smiling at me. Those words of wisdom? They are not words, I feel, but the silence in her voice, continually encouraging me in spite of my own disappointments, weaknesses and failures.

"Let it be done to me according to your word," she said to the angel Gabriel, when she was invited to be part of our salvation history. How better and more wonderful would our world be, if we only let God be.

The Roman Catholic Church, where we all belong, is my second mother. She is called in Greek ekklesia, which means a gathering or an assembly. I prefer to call her familia, because the Church is like a family to me. We are brothers and sisters, and our relationships are based on family structures.

Priests, by reason of their ordination and because they represent Christ, are called Fathers, as they are our spiritual fathers. They are wedded to the Church. With the wedding analogy, it might change things quite a bit. With marriages come in-laws. So in a way, my father-in-law now is Bishop O'Connell. (The late Bishop Smith was also my father-in-law once in the Diocese of Trenton. Bishop O'Connell succeeded him. And, when I first ministered in the Philippines, Bishop Varela was the father-in-law I initially served. Fancy that—three fathers-in-law for me as a priest. Lucky PJ!)

Then, there is my natural mother. She is the lady I first ever knew, whose face and beauty my eyes have first seen. Her name is Manuela, the feminine form of Emmanuel, which means "God is with us." Because of my Mama, I came to know about God. She taught me how to pray, how to believe and how to live my life. She brought me to God at Baptism. She offered me to God on my Ordination Day.

Nothing can escape a mother's eye, for moms are always watchful of their children's wellbeing. Nothing can prevent a mother's tears, if her children are suffering or in pain. If moms are to be faulted, it is because they love their children so much that they could get irrational about it.

I remember the comic strip Calvin and Hobbes. Calvin approaches his mother and asks, "Can Hobbes and I go play in the rain, Mom? The mother says, "No." Calvin asks, "Why not?" Mom says, "You'll get soaked." Calvin then asked, "What's wrong with that?" And the mother says, "You could catch pneumonia, run up a terrible hospital bill, linger a few months, and die." Calvin, looking out the window at the rain, says, "I always forget. If you ask a mom, you get a worse-case scenario." Hobbes adds, "I had no idea these little showers were so dangerous."

I learned a lot from my three mothers, just as I hope that you also learned a lot from yours. My three mothers are all divine creation. But, they are all human. Except for the Blessed Mother who was assumed into heaven, the Church and Mama are still anchored in this temporary life. Both of them are still beset by struggles and problems. Sometimes, either one of them may be misinterpreted or misunderstood. And all three of them I know, I will always and ever love.

To all mothers and to all women, who took the role of being mothers, cheers and blessings for all the sacrifices, understanding, and love you have shared!

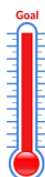

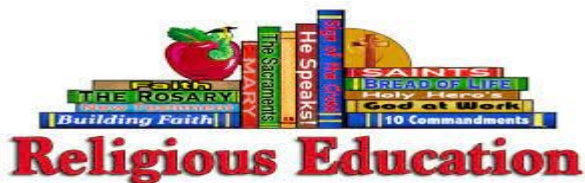

Synod Update: excerpts from monitor article 4/29/2022

"After nearly six months of parish and diocesan-based Listening Sessions, the Diocese of Trenton's Synod Committee is beginning the next portion of the diocesan phase of the 16th Ordinary Synod of Bishops."

"We are now in an intense reading phase where our Synod Committee of eight people is reading 789 group reports, 86 single interviews and 216 individual surveys submitted," said Synod co-chairperson Mary Liz Ivins."

"Over 4,500 voices were heard in the course of these months," Bishop O'Connell pointed out. "This has been a gift of God, to the praise and glory of God, and I thank all of you – especially the pastors – who have helped make this occasion possible."

The feedback of those voices in Listening Sessions will be submitted by the Bishop to the Episcopal Conference – the second or "continental phase," which in America is the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops. Following the USCCB review, the national collection of feedback will move to Rome to the "universal phase," which will conclude in October 2023.
