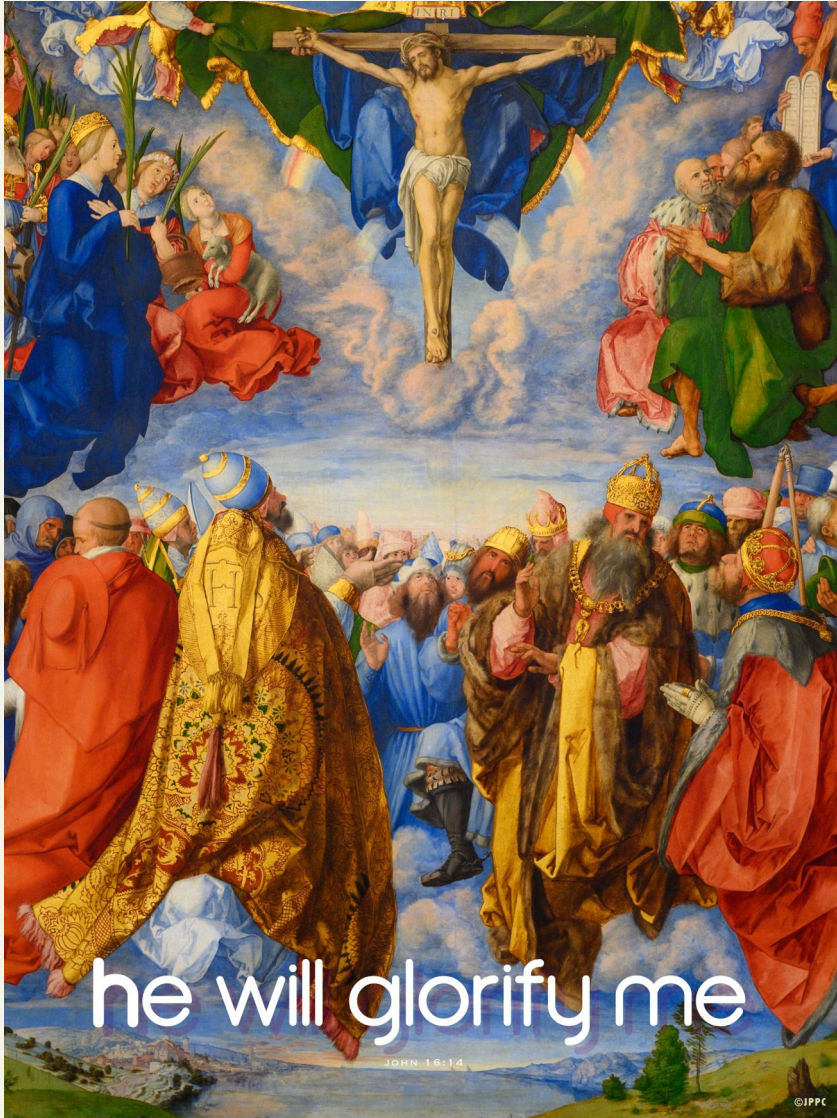

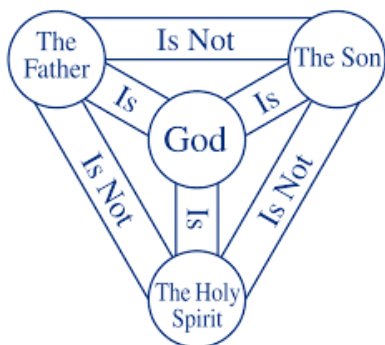

Notes from Fr. PJ

Dear Friends in Christ,

God's Blessings be upon you and your loved ones!

There is quite a lot of inadequacy, and even unworthiness, in writing about the Trinity. How can we talk about a Mystery? How can we express in simple terms and in flimsy analogies who God is? To talk about God the Father, and God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit—Three in One—has been a puzzler for many saints, and an enigma, for many of us, sinners.



As it is like in a mystery story, we try to piece together clues—bits and pieces of reality, and yes, lots of faith and prayer—in order to have a better understanding and picture of The Mystery.

Jesus Christ is the Complete Revelation of who God is.

If you want to know who God is, know Jesus. If you want to understand what God is, have a better understanding of Jesus, His Works and His commands. If you need to know where our lives are leading us, or how we hope it would end, have a better relationship with Jesus.

The Trinity is not about numbers—One in Three, Three in One. It is about a relationship. Jesus told us about His Father. He is also presented to us the Holy Spirit, our Advocate. He showed us who God is, what God is, when God is, where God is, why God is and how God is. His name, His Action, His Time and His Identity is LOVE.

John 3:16 is called the Golden Text because it has the greatest twelve words and phrases contained in one single verse. Every word and every phrase in it has a significant meaning.

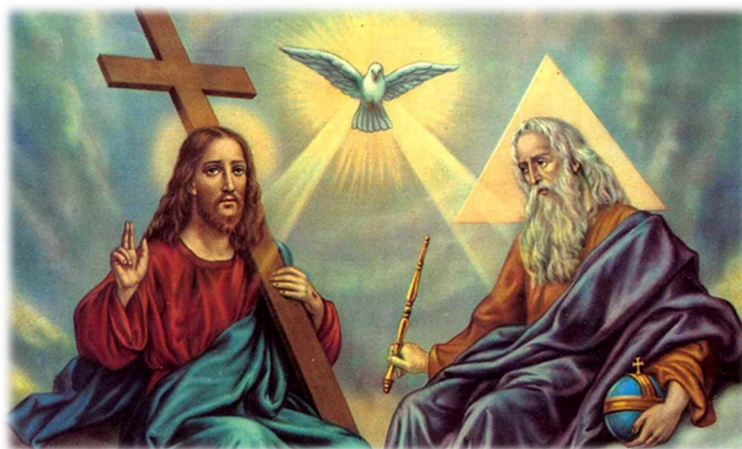


National Eucharistic Revival

What is the Eucharist Revival?

It is a movement of Catholics across the United States to be healed, converted, formed, and unified by an encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist—and sent out in mission “for the life of the world.” The National Eucharistic Revival and National Eucharistic Congress are a direct response to the Holy Father’s call for a “pastoral and missionary conversion which cannot leave things as they presently are” so that the Church in the United States might be “permanently in a state of mission” (Evangelii Gaudium, n. 25).

“It certainly is our hope that all of us in the Diocese will develop a deeper and more profound understanding and appreciation of the gift and mystery of the Holy Eucharist through active participation in weekly and daily Mass, through private prayer, Adoration and devotion to the Real Presence of the Lord Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament in our churches, and through a personal transformation that leads us to bring Christ’s loving presence into our communities. As we begin the Eucharistic Revival in our Diocese this June, let’s recall the words of Pope St. John Paul II: ‘From the Eucharist comes strength to live the Christian Life and zeal to share that life with others!’” Bishop David O’Connell

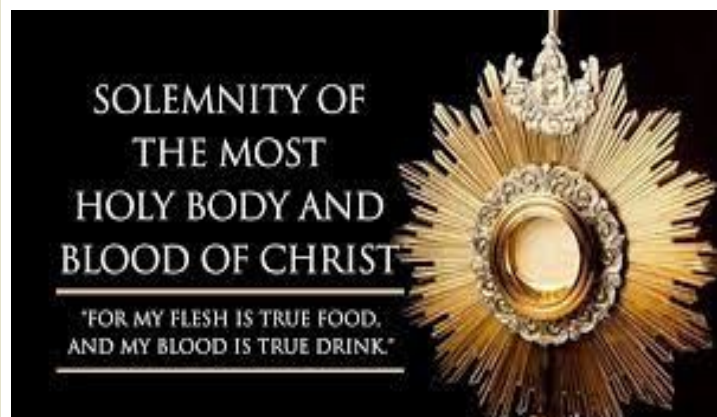

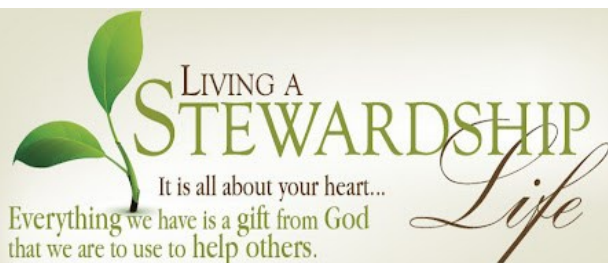

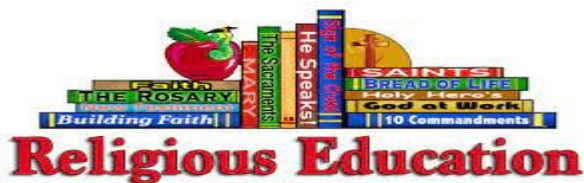
