Parish Updates from the Business Manager

Dear Parishioners,

The Parish office staff, clergy and I have had to address rumors circulating in the community about the usage of the school building attached to the church building after the school closure. St. Veronica is NOT selling the church or school buildings. St. Veronica Parish will celebrate her 60th Anniversary and so many parishioners and parish friends are looking forward to celebrating after Covid lockdowns and restrictions. Please participate in these celebrations to help reunite our parish family. There is a vacant piece of land bordering residential developments and our rear parking lot that we are considering selling. This sale was recommended to us by the diocesan Director of Construction and Real Estate, Scot Pirozzi, and Finance Council. The sale will help cover past parish debt and future expenses. The parish will secure a low interest loan from the diocese to cover remaining school closing costs. The loan will be split with St. Aloysius.

Last year, I reported on the extensive issues that we have with the rectory building from years of deferred maintenance. When I arrived, I was told, "there are no more band aids!" The rectory building houses the parish offices and is the primary living space for our clergy. Due to the much needed maintenance and the presence of mold caused by leaking AC piping, it was recommended the offices and clergy relocate to another space by December 31, 2021. Well, that date passed.... Unfortunately, no affordable rentals properties were available for the clergy or office space. With the school building becoming vacant, all parish offices will move there over the summer. Meeting spaces will also be created in the school building to accommodate parish ministries, committees, and outside groups who have been meeting at the parish for years, pre-covid. Religious Education classes will have dedicated rooms for instruction. Over the summer, the clergy will also move into the convent building giving them a private living space. Updates will need to be made to the wiring to accommodate the phone and computer systems. All the new technology and components installed in the rectory will be used in the convent and school buildings. The new rectory building (convent) will need updates. The main living area carpeting is 60 years old. If you have a business that can help the parish with updates (painting, carpeting, HVAC...) please reach out. Our parishioners are so successful with so much talent and expertise in their respective careers/businesses; your help can really aid the parish to reduce our improvement expenses.

I have been chipping away at deferred maintenance projects over the last year and many are planned for the next five years. For example, a repair of church/school chimney is estimated at nearly \$150,000. Your help is needed. You may have noticed over the last year that weekly expenses have been reported in the bulletin with the weekly stewardship numbers. You may have noticed that rarely the weekly offertory covers the weekly expenses. This should be alarming! Less than 50% of parish givers give weekly. A large percentage of givers give a few times a year. Unfortunately, there is very little funds left over for much needed repairs let alone weekly expenses. There is much we can do to increase our weekly offertory through consistent online giving and increased weekly and holiday contributions. I ask you to consider increasing your weekly giving and for those who do not give consistently to please begin giving more consistently. I have worked diligently to cut expenses and to acquire other sources of funds such as grants. Sadly, utility costs are on the rise, this has greatly affected St Veronica. Our previous cost for gas usage was 40 cents a therm. It is now over 90 cents a therm. Gas delivery charges have also increased. Like you, our gas expenses have doubled! I am working with several third party gas providers to secure the best price possible. Consolidating our four buildings into the three buildings will save the parish dollars. I am also working with the diocese to investigate rental options for a portion of the school building that the parish will not use. This will help defray expenses. Many groups have also contacted the parish office to rent space for events. These rentals are being considered.





What better way to celebrate Father's Day than spending it with God, the Father Almighty! Come join St. Veronica's Parish community for the highly-anticipated return of our 2022 Corpus Christi Eucharistic Procession on June 19, 2022 immediately following the noon Mass on the Mall area. Experience the blessings of a Corpus Christi procession led by our pastor, Fr. PJ and our 2022 First Communicants. All 2022 Communicants are encouraged to join in the procession.

After the procession, we will continue the celebration in the school cafeteria with light refreshments.

Feast of Corpus Christi is also called Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. In the Roman Catholic Church, it is observed in honor of the real presence of the body (corpus) of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. The Feast of Corpus Christi originated in 1246 when Robert de Torote, bishop of Liège, ordered the feast to be celebrated in his diocese by St. Juliana, prioress of Mont Cornillon near Liège (1222-58). St Juliana had experienced a vision. In 1264, Pope Urban IV ordered the whole church to observe the feast. In the 15th century Corpus Christi became one of the principal feasts of the church. The procession became the feast's most prominent feature.

We once again gather together as a Parish family to pray to our Blessed Mother in reparation for the offenses and sacrileges made against Her Immaculate Heart.





As noted last week, the drainage project was added as project #7. Lighting was moved to Project #8.

Project #7: Parking Lot Drainage



Goal = \$16,600. Phase 1: remove & replace broken catch basin, remove and repair asphalt. Phase 2: clean and remove all debris from 10 catch basin; clean and remove all debris down to the original install elevation of 8 dry wells. \$5,637.32 applied to this project \$10,962.68 away from reaching this goal

Project #8: Church Lighting



Goal = \$28,500. Repairs and upgrades to all church lighting. Replace all Par 56 bulbs to LED including the altar spot lighting. Replace all old fluorescent ballast lamps in dome lights over the pews. (Lamps rewired and ballasts removed). Add exterior lighting to illuminate Cross on church roof. Add lighting to Stations.



What is the Eucharist Revival?

It is a movement of Catholics across the United States to be healed, converted, formed, and unified by an encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist—and sent out in mission “for the life of the world.” The National Eucharistic Revival and National Eucharistic Congress are a direct response to the Holy Father’s call for a “pastoral and missionary conversion which cannot leave things as they presently are” so that the Church in the United States might be “permanently in a state of mission” (Evangelii Gaudium, n. 25).

“It certainly is our hope that all of us in the Diocese will develop a deeper and more profound understanding and appreciation of the gift and mystery of the Holy Eucharist through active participation in weekly and daily Mass, through private prayer, Adoration and devotion to the Real Presence of the Lord Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament in our churches, and through a personal transformation that leads us to bring Christ’s loving presence into our communities. As we begin the Eucharistic Revival in our Diocese this June, let’s recall the words of Pope St. John Paul II: ‘From the Eucharist comes strength to live the Christian Life and zeal to share that life with others!’” Bishop David O’Connell
