

Dear Friends in Christ,

Ten years ago, Covid-19 was unheard of, gas prices were pegged averagely at \$2.92 and Hurricane Sandy struck in October. It was also a decade ago when our parish celebrated half a century of grace and blessings, as the Jubilee Yearbook, published that year, phrased it.



A lot of things and events have transpired since then. Sadly, most of them were goodbyes, less were hellos. Deaths, transfers, relocation changes were the big factors. The weekly look into the history of our Parish Family, as documented by the Yearbook, named those 50 Years aptly and considerably—Window to the Past.



You are continually leading us to a deeper understanding of unity, compassion, and forgiveness.





Why is the Eucharist so important for the Church today?

The Catechism of the Catholic Church

I. THE EUCHARIST - SOURCE AND SUMMIT OF ECCLESIAL LIFE

1324 The Eucharist is "the source and summit of the Christian life."¹³⁶ "The other sacraments, and indeed all ecclesiastical ministries and works of the apostolate, are bound up with the Eucharist and are oriented toward it. For in the blessed Eucharist is contained the whole spiritual good of the Church, namely Christ himself, our Pasch."¹³⁷

1325 "The Eucharist is the efficacious sign and sublime cause of that communion in the divine life and that unity of the People of God by which the Church is kept in being. It is the culmination both of God's action sanctifying the world in Christ and of the worship men offer to Christ and through him to the Father in the Holy Spirit."¹³⁸

<u>1326</u> Finally, by the Eucharistic celebration we already unite ourselves with the heavenly liturgy and anticipate eternal life, when God will be all in all.¹³⁹

1327 In brief, the Eucharist is the sum and summary of our faith: "Our way of thinking is attuned to the Eucharist, and the Eucharist in turn confirms our way of thinking."¹⁴⁰

Jesus said: "I am the living bread that came down from heaven; if any one eats of this bread, he will live for ever; . . . he who eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life and . . . abides in me, and I in him" (Jn 6:51, 54, 56).
