



Notes from Fr. PJ

Dear Friends in Christ,

Peace!

Don't be foolish. Don't be a fool.

Who is the fool? It is the person who leaves God out of his/her life. Who is the fool? It is the person who thinks more of what he/she wants, not what he/she basically needs. Who is the fool? It is the person who, as Ecclesiastes wrote about in the First Reading, finds

no meaning and significance in what human life essentially offers—vanity of vanities! All things are vanity!

The Hebrew word for vanity is hebel. It basically denotes "vapor" or "breath." Figuratively, it means something futile, useless, insubstantial, short-lived, vacuous, or in Spanish, nada. To nothingness, like a puff of air, if we have to be imaginative about it.

Don't be foolish. Don't be a fool.

Our good Lord called the rich man, the farmer—a fool. Being rich is not sinful. Having properties is not sinful. Possessing things we value, love and like may not be sinful.

And yet, the subject in this weekend's parable, the rich man who decided to build more barns for his harvest, was called by Jesus a FOOL.

Foolishness is sinful, once we leave God out of our lives. Foolishness is sinful, especially to a person who builds windowless barns. Had there been a window in that barn, the farmer could have seen an image of God in one of his neighbors. Foolishness is sinful in a farmer, whose mirror in the house, may be his only friend.

Ah---vanity of vanities. Exactly!

With all the toil and anxiety of heart with which he labored under the sun, as Ecclesiastes wrote, what profit comes from it? Sorrow, grief, and sleepless nights.

There's only one prayer I could utter as I write this: may the good Lord **not** say to us one day, as He said to the rich man, "and the things you have prepared to whom will they belong?"

Don't be foolish. Don't be a fool.

Store up treasures in heaven, not on earth. Treasures on earth just fade away, like a vanishing vapor, a vanity, a hebel.




MISSION APPEAL WEEKEND - August 6 & 7
