

### Notes from Fr. PJ

Dear Friends in Christ,

Peace!

"I do not know where you are from. Depart from me, all you evildoers!" I think those could be the most horrifying words ever recorded. These are words we would rather not hear ourselves, either addressed to those who have done evil or please heaven forbid, addressed to us and people we know and love.



A question led us to this horrendous statement--"Lord, will only a few people be saved?" The question was addressed to Jesus, while he made his way through towns and villages en route to Jerusalem. The questioner acknowledged Jesus as Lord, and limited his notion of salvation to just a few. He was being exclusive.

Notice that Jesus did not answer directly the man (or maybe a woman?) who asked. St. Luke recorded that He answered them. Our good Lord, as always, is very inclusive.

"Strive to enter through the narrow gate," he told them. Many, not just a few as the man had asked, will attempt to enter, but will not be strong enough.

Then Jesus told them about the master of the house who rose and locked the door. The many, who tried to enter, stood outside knocking and pleading that the door be opened.

The master in reply said, "I do not know where you are from." We know you, they said. We were with you, eating and drinking. You taught in our streets.

Those words are not enough. Eating and drinking with the master of the house, and saying that he taught in their streets are not guarantees to entering his house.

Then came the big blow--"I do not know where you are from. Depart from me, all you evildoers!"

Do we know where we are from? We could say we are from our town of origin or birth. Or, from where we are presently residing.

But, do we really know where we are from?

The master of the house did not know the many, who knocked and asked that the lock be opened. Though it was a narrow gate, they did not have the strength to know more about the master and the master to know about them. They were estranged from the master.

Strangers are hard to know, because that is what they are--strange. They could not have any relationship with the master, not even being friends. Maintaining and developing a relationship is alien to a stranger.

Moral of the story? Know the Master of the house, who has the power to unlock the door. Read His story. Follow His example. Do what He says and commands.

One other scenario: you knock and ask to come in. The Master says, "I know you. You are my friend. Come in."

That would be the most comforting words we would ever hear.

Ever and forever.




#### Why is it so important for the Church today to have an

**Eucharistic Revival?** (excerpt from Diocese of Trenton Website) All parishes have experienced a significant decline in the number of people coming to Mass and receiving the Sacraments in the recent past. Our own diocesan assessments have shown that this is a reality. 




