Notes from Fr. PJ

Dear Friends in Christ,

Peace!

You may have heard this story before. There was a man, who won a medal for humility. A week later, the awards committee took the medal from him. Apparently, he was wearing the medal of humility, even in the showers and in his sleep.



Pride—the danger of pride. The serpent was so cunning that it made Adam and Eve proud. “A little bite in that apple won’t hurt you,” as the snake probably said as it slithered away from them. Pride destroyed their obedient relationship with God. Humility restored this relationship centuries later. A humble Fiat—let it be done to me according to your word—from mankind’s solitary boast, the Blessed Virgin Mary, brought us back to God.

Pride is difficult to see in ourselves. It is basically the attitude that says, “Look at me, I am the center of the universe. I enjoy being the center of attention.” The proud person’s three favorite personal pronouns are: I, me and my. That person finds it difficult to admit that he or she could be wrong. That person could be stubborn or even arrogant with his or her dealings with others. That person does not want to be corrected. Pride makes people think with their super big egos, that they are always right.

So, this self-proclaimed genius walks into a bar one day and says, “I’m the smartest person in the world. In fact, I know every single word in this dictionary!” he yells at the crowd. One of the customers takes the dictionary and says, “Okay, smart guy, tell me the meaning of the words “humility, charity, and patience.” The genius replies, “Oh, so you’re just gonna make up your own words now, are you?”

The Gospel Reading we have this weekend happened at a party. As the guests arrive, Jesus must have seen them grabbing the front row seats, places of honor. Understandably so since as human beings, we prefer to have the best seat. Even in parking places, the best one is that which is closest, or maybe during this hot summer season, the one under a tree with plenty of shades. At a theater or a play, the best one might be right in the very middle where you have the best view. Churches also have some best seats in some parishes during weekend Masses. They prefer the row on the back. Those are the ones that fill up first. Thank God for our ushers, we don’t have that at St. Veronica’s.

So, as the Pharisees were also observing our Savior, Jesus could not help but tell them about a parable. Just be humble enough and know yourself. That is what Jesus is telling us today. Pride is the friend of the devil. Humility is its enemy. God looks at us intently and sees through our hearts, what is deep inside of us. When God sees a truly humble heart, that person will surely be exalted in His eyes.

So, here’s more preachy notes. In our busy lives we tend to forget the best exercise—that of bending one’s knees and raising up one’s hands in surrender to God. Try as we might, we can’t go on running away from God and what He wants us to do with our lives. Or, can we in resentment, continue to fight God?

Stop fighting God. You’ll never win. Be not proud. You’ll lose.

Start loving God and the people He created for you on your life journey. You will win. Just be humble, so that you will not stumble. And even if at one point, or several points in life, you stumble, get up. Because in actuality, we are the poor, the crippled, the lame and the blind Jesus mentioned in the parable. In His sacred Table, the eternal Banquet of Life, we have no ability to repay Him for what He has given and shared with us.

Just be humble. No need to wear a medal. If you do, you’ll go places—better and higher.
