Notes from Fr. PJ

Dear Friends in Christ,

Peace!

These notes come with the hope that you had a restful summer. I was in Greenland and Iceland during the first two weeks of August. It was quite an experience communing with God's created nature, and just marveling how the world was created by our God, who loved us from the start. I saw glaciers and geysers, fissures and moss-covered mountains. I had a dip in the touristy Blue Lagoon, celebrated Mass at a sparsely populated Qaqortoq (Greenland) and had reindeer meat for an appetizer (tasted like chicken. Touche!) Anyway, here are some notable items:



- Thank you to **Claire McCarthy** for serving as one of our Parish Trustees. She has served in this capacity for a good number of years and has been volunteering with her time and talent ever since. Since she has to relocate closer to her children, she could no longer attend to her duty as a Trustee. Sadly, we bid her well and once again, we are grateful for all that she has been to us. You are in our prayers, Claire, and please know that you are dearly loved and remembered.
- Welcome and thank you to **Denise Daye** for accepting the role of a Parish Trustee. Denise is a member of our Pastoral Council and has also been actively involved in our parish. I am glad and honored that she said yes to my invitation. Denise, thank you and more blessings to you and your family, as you take on this role.
- Eucharist is originally a Greek word that means "Thanksgiving." This weekend, as we celebrate the **25th Anniversary of our Perpetual Adoration Chapel**, we cannot help but again give thanks to God for all the blessings we have. **Debbie Revoir**, our Coordinator, prepared a program souvenir for the occasion, listing down the original Adorers (they haven't aged a bit during those 25 years with their constant and regular exposure to the Eucharistic light), the Adorers who are now in the next life, and Adorers who have done sacrificial hours. St. Veronica's Parish is a prayerful and praying community. Let us keep it that way. For those who have yet to sign up as Adorer, please do so. The benefit and gain you'll get from just being present with the Lord are outstanding, and goes beyond our time (even affecting generations after us) and space.
- Sunday is **9/11**. Please join me in prayer for those who perished 21 years ago and for their families. Hail Mary full of grace, the Lord is with thee. Blessed art thou amongst women and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen. Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. Amen.
- *A pause here, as we bow our heads after that prayer.*
- Bishop O'Connell thanks you for your generous contribution to the **Collection for the Retired and Infirm Priests in our Diocese**. At the latest update, our Parish is in the Top 10 in the list of top-givers. Being in the list means something to me. Not only because I am your priest (still 15 long years before retirement, but knock on wood, not infirmed), but because you really responded to our Bishop's call. I have a daily prayer that I say for priests, ever since I was ordained. I do that not because I am one, but because I know the challenges and difficulties a priest has in life.
- You share in our challenges, which is the better point. Last Thursday, we had a good turnout of parishioners who were at the **Leadership Convocation for Eucharistic Revival**. Fr. Chang and I (and our clergy in Trenton) may be limited in number because of ordination, but by reason of our baptism and confirmation, you are the extensions of our Christian mission.
- Next Saturday, September 17th at the 4 PM Mass, the **Legion of Mary** will have a celebration, which will be followed by Procession from the Church to the Grotto. The Holy Rosary will be recited and refreshment follow in the Parish Hall. On September 18th at the 10:30 A.M. Mass, there will also be a Blessing of Catechists. This is also observed as **Catechetical Sunday**, as we thank and honor our catechists who teach our children the basic tenets of our Christian Faith. Welcome and warm wishes to **Stacey Schear**, our PCL Leader and her staff, **Sharon Krause** and **Mira Welnowska**, as they begin the new Catechetical Year. (I will also be at St. Mary's in Colts Neck that weekend preaching at all their Masses for the Missions.)

This is a lot for now. Keep well, everyone, and regards.

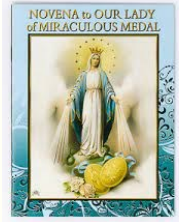
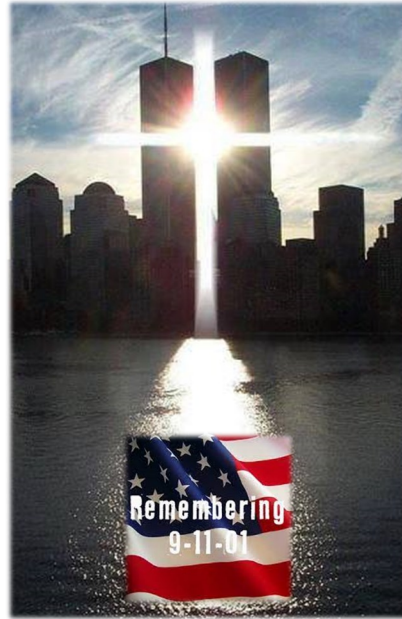

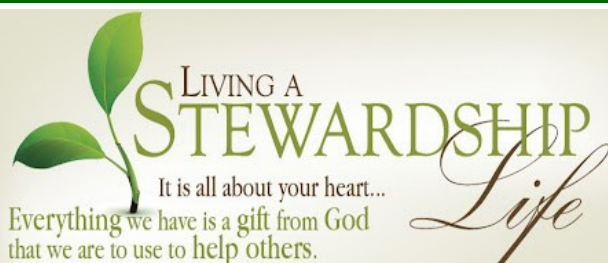

CHURCH LIGHTING CAMPAIGN & SPONSORSHIP

LED by the Light



Sponsorships are now available for the twelve (12) "lamps" or chandeliers in St. Veronica Church. Full Lamp Sponsorship is \$1200 per chandelier. Half Sponsorship is \$600, and a quarter sponsorship is \$300.

This sponsorship opportunity will upgrade chandeliers to LED lighting with bright white bulbs. Not only will this bring us more light to illuminate our worship space and "amplify our presence" but it will also reduce our energy costs.

Fr. PJ noted this high priority in his September 4th bulletin letter: "...we need more lights in our Church, our dear St. Veronica Church. These are the lights that are not focused on the altar, but lights that shine upon us, Church-goers, and amplifies our presence in our worship space."

Lamp Locations: Chandeliers 1,2,3,4 are nearest to the altar and sanctuary. Chandeliers 5,6,7,8 are in the middle of the church and chandeliers 9,10,11, and 12 are in the rear of the church closest to the loft. (map of locations to follow)

Update from the Business Manager con't:

In last week's bulletin 7 deferred maintenance projects and campus upgrades were noted. Here are a few others
8) The Surveillance camera system for the Church building and parking lots was completed. We now have 24/7 access and monitoring of our camera system. The monitor in the parish office will be the central location for viewing activity on our campus during business hours. Web access and notifications will alert us activity all other times of the day and evening.



9) The school's intercom and camera system was reconnected at the Parish Center entrance door. Now parish staff can see, greet and grant access to visitors as needed. Three additional intercoms will be re-installed in other location within the building.

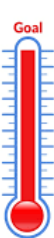
10) Estimates for the next phases of Surveillance Security Upgrade Project is underway 1) update the Surveillance camera system in the rear of the campus and within the Parish Center building. We have access but it is not web-based. 2) Upgrade the fob access system in the Parish Center will allow scheduling of doors and guest passes for renters. 3) closure of the roadway between the field and the trailers to prevent cars from loitering in the evening hours. 4) installing no trespassing signage on the campus perimeter 5) updating the no-thru way signage to reduce drive/cut-thru traffic on the parish campus.

11) Setting up of additional office and meeting space is underway after our move. The deacon's office will soon be available. Boxes of faith formation materials are being unpacked in the Center for Learning and Classrooms are being set up for Religious Education.

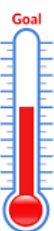

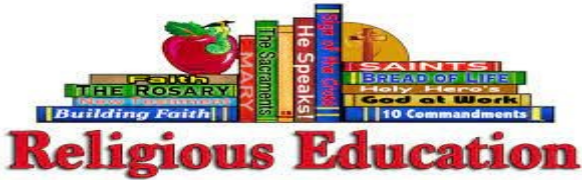

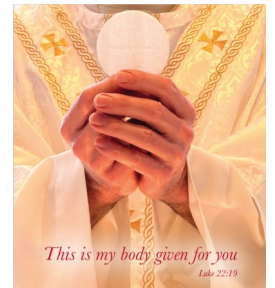
Catechetical Sunday - Sept 18, 2022 at the 10:30 Mass

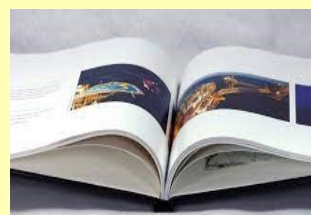

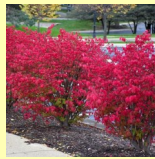
