

Notes from Fr. PJ

Dear Friends in Christ,

Peace!

In the Bible, light has always been a symbol of holiness, wisdom, grace, hope and God's goodness. Light is God's eldest daughter. It was created even before the sun and the moon, as written in the Book of Genesis. Light came into existence through God's word alone.

Jesus has used light as an analogy for quite a number of times. Foremost among them is the command that we are called to be the light of the world.

Now, if somehow you are getting the drift of these notes, you are right. I think we need more lights in our Church, our dear St. Veronica Church. These are the lights that are not focused on the altar, but lights that shine upon us, Churchgoers, and amplifies our presence in our worship space.

There is a legend of a village in Southern Europe that boasted of a church called "The House of Many Lamps." When it was built in the sixteenth century, the architect provided for no light except for a receptacle at every seat for the placing of a lamp. Each Sunday night, as the people gathered, they would bring their lanterns and slip them into the bracket at their seat. When someone stayed away, their place would be dark; and if very many stayed away, the darkness became greater for the whole.

It was the regular presence of each person that lit up the church.

We have a blessed opportunity here at St. Veronica to sponsor one of our 12 "lamps" or chandeliers in our church. Inside this bulletin, too, is the recommended amount that we need for every lamp/chandelier. We hope to install L.E.D. lights by mid-September. So, if you have an unspent vacation money, or any surplus, or a gift that you could do to light up our Church, perhaps you might be able to chip in for our lighting project.

We have other projects done, some still ongoing. Thank you, as always, for your abiding support, assistance and generosity.



Newly baptized persons are holy because the Holy Trinity begins to dwell in their souls and they are pleasing to God. The second sanctification is a lifelong process in which a person already in the state of grace grows in the possession of grace and in likeness to God by faithfully corresponding with divine inspirations. The third sanctification takes place when a person enters heaven and becomes totally and irrevocably united with God in the beatific vision. (Ety. Latin *sanctificare*, to make holy.)





We are Called to Develop & Serve

Update from the Business Manager:

There are many projects going on around our St. Veronica Campus. The parish offices moved out of the rectory and into the Parish Center (formally the school building) on August 6th. The move went well thanks to many volunteers and staff helping who packed up the offices and parish files. The moving company was amazing. The IT switch over went very well thanks to Anthony DeLorenzo and his electricians who worked till 9PM getting the parish online for business on Monday. Our only glitches were restoring wifi to the rectory and the copy machine being offline which was remedied the following Monday, Aug 8. Thanks to many volunteers, the school building is 70% cleaned out. This work has been going on since July 1st when STV took possession of the facilities. All room and closet were filled with miscellaneous educational items, books, furniture and much garbage. Books, science equipment and furniture items are being donated to various Catholic schools that requested items. They are grateful for these donations. Other projects that are going on are as follows:

- 1) The convent is receiving a facelift in preparation of the priests moving in to their new residence. The move will take place in the fall. New vinyl flooring was added to the main hall way and dining room on the 1st floor and new carpeting was installed in the living room and 2nd floor hallway. The rugs in the bedrooms are in good shape so they will be shampooed. Some rooms will be painted. The building is being cleaned out of excess furniture and I now have four estimates on updating the A/C. The sliding door in the living room needs replacement.
- 2) John has been cutting the grass which has saved the parish thousands of dollars. He is also watering all our new plantings of trees and bushes from the our tree sponsorship campaign. Scalici landscaping was hired to clean up the parish grounds around the buildings. They have been pulling weeds, trimming bushes, cutting back trees around the parish center entrance and putting down new mulch.
- 3) Updated parish signage is also in the works. The MSA sign was removed from the front of the property along Route 9. The four brown directional signs you see when entering the campus are covered and will be repainted with new arrows and lettering installed. A new sign "Saint Veronica Church" will be installed on the façade of the Narthex extension. "Convent" and "rectory" building lettering will be removed. We will retain "Saint Veronica" on the front of the rectory building. Those letters will be cleaned, refinished and reused. The old green St Veronica sign along Route 9 will be moved to the residential entrance side of the campus. No electric will be run to the sign.
- 4) Drainage issues are being worked on. Soon eleven dry well basins will be cleaned out of the two feet of garbage preventing them from draining properly. A new sink hole has formed in the rear parking lot. Drain behind the preschool rear exit is overflowing into the building with every heavy rain. Gutters and downspouts needs to be cleaned out. Underground pipe for convent leader was

damaged last year by stump grinder and will need to be repaired.

- 5) Church lighting is a high priority as Fr PJ noted in his letter this week. The lighting upgrades will be made in September. All lights will be changed to bright white and switched to LED. Morning Mass will be moved to the Narthex for a few days so that scaffolding can be set up to reach the chandler fixtures and the spots. The Church sound system is also slated for upgrades this fiscal year. More information about that project will follow.
- 6) Installation of new doors is being priced out. The project includes: 1) creating separations in the Parish Center between office/parish meeting space and outside renters who will be using the building, 2) replacement of security doors between the church and the parish center, and 3) Handicap accessibility at the Church entrance.
- 7) The leak in the church roof over the altar will also be repaired this fall as well. This is an easy fix as Deacon Gino informed me that this leak is caused by loose caulking around vents.

There is never enough space to write all I need to inform you for transparency. Know that I have the parish's best interest in mind with every decision that I make to be a good steward of your donations which fund the many projects.
