



1,402 ACTIVE Parishioner Households + 92 families listed as CONTRIBUTOR or VISITOR






Our total REVENUE for the fiscal year 2023-2024 was below what was budgeted by \$10,485. Total EXPENSES were also below what was budgeted for the fiscal year by \$19,274.

\$1,245,765 REVENUE - \$1,236,976 EXPENSES = \$8,789 The Fiscal Year ended \$8,789 in EXCESS OF REVENUE over EXPENSES.

Each year, we prepare a parish budget reviewed by our accountant and approved by our pastor, trustees and finance council. In the parish's FY 2023-2024 budget plan, approximately \$24,158.65 per week was allocated to cover parish expenses. Some weeks we were below that target number and some weeks we are over. This fluctuation is based on many factors but primarily due dates on invoices.







October Count stats.... The Diocese of Trenton requires parishes to report average Mass attendance for two weekends in October. This is known as the October Count. After the Covid Pandemic in 2020, 61% of Mass attendees did not return to Mass. Since 2020's Mass Count of zero, average Mass attendance increased in 2021 (678) and 2022 (1034). However, we reported a decrease in 2023 of 4% compared to 2022's October average of 1034.

However, the good news is that our ushers track Mass attendance every weekend which has indicated that our weekly attendance average has increased by 2.5%.
